I-25 Wearing Course Overlay Construction From Santa Fe County Line to Waldo Canyon Interchange

The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) will begin a wearing course overlay project on I-25 starting from MM 263 (Santa Fe County line) to MM 268 (Waldo Canyon Interchange) on June 5.

The wearing course overlay will provide a thin overlay of hot mix asphalt. The contractor will begin work on the southbound lanes and then upon completion of the southbound lanes will move to the northbound lanes.

This project is scheduled to last three weeks with an anticipated completion date of June 22, weather permitting.

During the project motorists can expect delays on I25 starting Tuesday June 5 between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m.

Drivers are asked to proceed through the work zone with caution, observe temporary traffic control signing, and observe posted speed limits.
