I-25 Wearing Course Overlay Construction From Santa Fe County Line to Waldo Canyon Interchange Update

The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) began a wearing course overlay project on I-25 starting from MM 263 (Santa Fe County line) to MM 268 (Waldo Canyon Interchange) on June 6.

This project is scheduled to last three weeks with an anticipated completion date of June 22, weather permitting.

There has been a change in working hours. During the project motorists can expect delays on the southbound lanes of I-25 as follows:

- Thursday June 7 between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m.
- Friday June 8 between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m.
- Saturday June 9 between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m.
- Monday June 11 between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m.

Upon completion of the southbound lanes, which is anticipated by Monday June 11, the contractor will begin working on the northbound lanes of I-25. During the northbound paving, motorists can expect delays on the northbound lanes of I-25 as follows:

• Starting Tuesday June 12 until completion of the project between the hours of 9:00 am and 3:00 p.m.

Drivers are asked to proceed through the work zone with caution, observe temporary traffic control signing, and observe posted speed limits.
