I-25 Bridge Rehabilitation North of Santa Fe

Santa Fe – The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) began bridge replacement work on I-25 north of Santa Fe at Canoncito (between mile markers 293 and 294) on April 7, 2014. The scope of the project includes bridge rehabilitation, roadway and ramp reconstruction and pavement rehabilitation for 1.42 miles within Santa Fe County.

There are left lane closures on the northbound and southbound lanes of I-25. Temporary wall barriers have been set up leaving one lane open through the work zone. The lane closures will be in effect until November.

Motorists can expect minor delays. The posted speed limit is 55 mph through the work zone. There is a 12 foot width restriction in effect.

This \$8.2 million bridge replacement and roadway rehabilitation project is scheduled for completion in the spring of 2015. The Federal Highway Administration and NMDOT have partnered to fund the improvements. AUI Inc. of Albuquerque is the project's contractor.

NMDOT urges motorists to proceed through the work zone with caution, watch for construction personnel, observe traffic control signing and reduce their speed.
