
Paseo Del Norte/I-25 Interchange Reconstruction Project Announces Saturday Night Closure of Paseo Del Norte Between Jefferson and Second Street

Closure is Needed so that Crews Can Realign Paseo Del Norte near the Railroad Crossing

ALBUQUERQUE – The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) has announced that both directions of Paseo Del Norte will be <u>completely closed</u> between 2nd Street and Jefferson from <u>9 p.m. Saturday, June 14 through 5 a.m. Sunday, June 15</u> so that crews can realign Paseo Del Norte near the area where there is a railroad crossing. Eastbound traffic will be diverted to Second Street and Osuna, and westbound traffic will be diverted to Jefferson and Alameda, but <u>motorists are encouraged to use an alternate route if possible.</u>

In other weekend work, I-25 southbound will be reduced to one lane at San Antonio from 9 p.m. Friday June 13 until 5 a.m. Saturday, June 14 and will have a single right lane closure until 5 a.m. Monday, June 16. I-25 southbound will be closed from Alameda to Paseo Del Norte from 9 p.m. Saturday June 14 through 5 a.m. Sunday, June 15. Motorists traveling on southbound I-25 over the weekend should expect delays at times.

The Paseo Del Norte/I-25 Interchange Reconstruction Project is a project of the New

Mexico Department of Transportation in partnership with the Federal Highway Administration, City of Albuquerque and Bernalillo County and in cooperation with the Mid-Region Council of Governments.
