## I-25 Bridge Work to Begin July 18 Santo Domingo

**Santa Fe**—The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) will begin bridge rehabilitation work on I-25, mile maker 264 at Santo Domingo (bottom of La Bajada Hill) south of Santa Fe on July 18, 2014.

Starting Friday, July 18 at 7:00 p.m., the I-25 northbound lanes will be reduced to one lane. The reduced lanes will be in effect until Sunday, June 20, 2014. Motorists can expect minor delays. The bridge rehabilitation work is scheduled over the next several weekends.

This bridge rehabilitation project is anticipated to be completed by August 17, weather permitting. The Federal Highway Administration and NMDOT have partnered to fund the improvements. Interstate Highway Construction of Albuquerque is the contractor for this project.

Drivers are urged to proceed through the work zone with caution, observe traffic control signs and obey speed limits. Updates on this project will be posted on the New Mexico Department of Transportation's road conditions website, <a href="https://www.nmroads.com">www.nmroads.com</a>
