I-25 East Frontage Road & I-25 NB Off-Ramp (Exit 282) Pavement Preservation Work to Begin October 2

Santa Fe—The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) will begin the final stage of pavement preservation work on the I-25 East Frontage Road from NM 599 to the Waldo Canyon Interchange on October 2, 2014. There will be one lane closures with a flagger and pilot car operation escort through the work zone from 8:30 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

On Saturday, October 4, 2014 the I-25 Northbound off-ramp (Exit 282) to St. Francis Drive will be CLOSED from 9:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. for pavement preservation work. During this closure motorists can use the Old Pecos Trail off-ramp (Exit 284) or the Cerrillos Road off-ramp (Exit 278)

This pavement preservation work is anticipated to be completed October 6, 2014; weather permitting.

Drivers are urged to proceed through the work zones with caution, observe traffic control signs and observe posted speed limits. Updates on this project will be posted on the New Mexico Department of Transportation's road advisory website, www.nmroads.com
