I-10/Mesquite & Vado Bridge Interchange Mesquite, NM

Las Cruces - The District One office for the New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) with El Terrero Construction continue with the I-10 Bridge overpass at the Mesquite exit. Currently the contractor has placed concrete beams across the eastbound I-10 interstate lanes, and will proceed with the placement of the concrete bridge deck. The contractor will need to begin the removal of the ramps in order to reconstruct the eastbound on and off ramps at Mesquite exit 151.

The contractor will need to **close** access to the eastbound on and off ramps (exit 151), in order realign the approaches as they will tie into the newly constructed design for the Mesquite interchange. This closure will be placed by Monday September 8th at 8:00 am and is scheduled to be lifted by the end of business on Monday October 20, 2014.
