Under Voie's leadership, WIT has undertaken numerous initiatives to raise awareness and encourage women to get involved in the transportation industry, including the Accelerate! Conference and Expo and annual Salute to Women Behind the Wheel event.

"I'm honored to be named a "Pro to Know" because this recognition helps call attention to the underrepresentation of women in the transportation industry and provides an opportunity to highlight the value that women can contribute," Voie said. "As drivers, women can help to address the current capacity crunch. As leaders, studies show, women can significantly impact business success. If we all work together, we can help to move the industry forward."
