NMDOT Announces Construction to Begin Nov. 13 on I-25 San Antonio to Jefferson Project

Albuquerque, NM – The New Mexico Department of Transportation announced that work will begin November 13, 2017, for the I-25 San Antonio to Jefferson project. This project will help add capacity by widening Interstate 25.

- This project will construct an additional lane on southbound I-25 from San Antonio to Jefferson and a second lane on the northbound off ramp at the San Antonio Interchange.
- Phase 1 of the project will include bridge and roadway widening.
- November 13, 2017 through May 31, 2018, I-25 NB & SB at Exit 230 (San Mateo Blvd) will have various shoulder and lane restrictions throughout the duration of the project.
- I-25 southbound off ramp to San Mateo Blvd will be closed as of November 13, 2017. Detours will be provided along I-25 southbound alerting motorists to exit at San Antonio or Jefferson. There will also be a left lane closure on the southbound frontage road between San Antonio & Jefferson.
- San Mateo Blvd / Osuna Rd will have various lane and shoulder restrictions throughout the duration of the project.
- Some operations will require nighttime closures of I-25 & San Mateo/Osuna for which advanced notice will be provided.
