AUI AND NMDOT ENTER FINAL PHASE OF CONSTRUCION ON I-40 LOUISIANA INTERCHANGE PROJECT; WESTBOUND I-40 ON-RAMP AND VARIOUS SOUTHBOUND LOUISIANA LANES TO BE CLOSED

ALBUQUERQUE, July 3, 2018—The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) and AUI will enter the final phase of construction on the I-40 Louisiana Interchange beginning Thursday, July 5. During Phase 2-D, which is expected to last through early to mid-August, the following traffic impacts will be in place:

- The westbound I-40 on-ramp will be closed. Travelers will be able to access I-40 westbound from San Mateo at I-40 or Wyoming at I-40;
- The northbound turning ramps to the westbound I-40 on-ramp will also be closed;
- Three right southbound Louisiana lanes will be closed in the area of the interchange. Drivers should expect delays and use an alternate route if possible.

Work will be going on 24 hours a day, seven days a week, so motorists are asked to use extra caution in the construction zone.
