TNT Super Series announces inaugural Trailer Shop/ERD Race Of Champions

Elite event promises to find the best 10.90 sportsman drag

JORDAN STATION, ONTARIO (May 14, 2011) The Joe's Transmission TNT Super Series (TNTSS) is very excited to announce the first-ever TNTSS Race of Champions (ROC) presented by The Trailer Shop/ERD. Cayuga Dragway at Toronto Motorsports Park will host the ROC for this elite group of sportsman drag racers on Saturday September 3rd as part of its Labor Day weekend events.





Exclusively for TNTSS event winners, the only way to get into the Trailer Shop/ERD Race of Champions is to have won a TNTSS event at any time in the series history. The ROC winner will receive \$1200 and the runner-up will get \$600.
