About Crew Chief Richie Wauters: Starting at the tracks around Green Bay, WI Richie Wauters quickly moved into the NASCAR Touring Series. Wauters crewed successful NASCAR Nationwide Series teams with Rusty Wallace and Johnny Sauter. Wauters, who has worked for Billy Ballew Motorsports for the past ten years, led the team to its first victory in 2004 and has continued to lead as the team scored nine more victories during the 2005-2008 NASCAR Camping World Truck Series seasons. Wauters set up the first truck race that NSCS Driver Kyle Busch ran in the Camping World Truck at the Lowes Motor Speedway where he won that event. In his off time Wauters still focuses on racing with his Late Model team. The team won the Snow Ball Derby in 2004 and finished second in 2005. His NASCAR Southeast Series team has nine wins over two seasons. The team won the Southeastern Elite Division Championship and won the last race of the Elite Division at the Phoenix International Raceway at the end of 2006. Wauters has worked with drivers such as; Rusty and Steven Wallace, Kyle Busch, John Andretti, Jeremy Mayfield, Paul Menard, Denny Hamlin, Shane Sieg, Brian Ickler, Aric Almirola and a host of other top NASCAR drivers.

Rowdy Returns to Trucks in Thunder Valley- Kyle "Rowdy" Busch the No. 51 Miccosukee Resort/Graceway Pharmaceutical Toyota Tundra returns to Bristol Motor Speedway as the defending race champion of the O'Reilly 200 NASCAR Camping World Truck Series race.

Busch dominated the 2008 race leading 145 of 203 laps in the Billy Ballew Motorsports entry on the 0.533-mile high banked oval race track.

The 24-year old driver has visited victory lane in each of the Top-Three NASCAR Touring Series posting one win, two top-five and three top-10 finishes in NASCAR Camping World Truck Series, one win, five top-five, eight top-10 finishes and one pole in 10 Nationwide Series starts and nine NASCAR Sprint Cup Series starts posting two wins, four top-five and six top-10 finishes.

Billy Ballew Motorsports has nine previous starts at Bristol Motor Speedway with one win, three top-five and five top-10 finishes at the Thunder Valley short track.

Richie Wauters, who in his tenure as crew chief for Billy Ballew Motorsports has led the team to ten of the 12 posted victories, will return as the crew chief on the No. 51 Miccosukee Resort Tundra for the remainder of the 2009 series season.

Wauters knows the how the steep 36° turns and 16°straightaways on the concrete Bristol Motor Speedway can play on the setup of the truck.

"Concrete is a rougher surface and is not heat sensitive," Wauters continued. "It doesn't change from day to night. The track gets black with the more rubber down on it making the truck tighter so we anticipate for that in our set up. I don't know if the softer right side tire should have an overall effect on the grip. It may play into a different pit strategy of pitting twice if the tires wear out. We might have to make two pit stops for tires instead of the usual one and done."

Miccosukee Resort & Gaming will serve as the primary sponsor with Graceway Pharmaceuticals; LLC headquartered in Bristol, TN will serve as the associate sponsor on the No. 51 Billy Ballew Motorsports Tundra.

The O'Reilly 200 presented by Valvoline 200 lap/106.6 mile NASCAR Camping World Series race is slated for Wednesday, August 19, 2009 at 8:30pm ET. SPEED will televise the race live beginning at 8:00pm ET with MRN and Sirius Satellite Radio coverage beginning at 8:15pm ET.
