Product Review: MotorHead Miniature Figures

At the iHobby in October I came across the booth for MotorHead Miniatures. They feature a wide range of resin figures that come prepainted in several scales, for car modelers there are 1/18, 1/24 and 1/32 series. They are nicely packaged in clear blister packs with attractive graphics. They also distribute the Spec Cast brand die casts. You can see all their products at www.motorheads4u.com.





There is the Fast Women series, of racy females to pose next to your models. Also there are mechanics and other figures in a variety of poses. Above are Kaitlyn and Duke (all the figures have names). The figures come in a choice of colors, both individually and in sets.

They were selling these at the booth so I picked up four in 1/24 scale. These are relatively inexpensive, so the details are okay for posing next to models on the shelf but they are not contest level. Same goes for the paint finish. It would be possible to detail paint the figures to make them appear a bit more realistic. The subject matter to me seems a bit retro, 50's and 60's but there are lots of hot rods and muscle car models out there. They also have other diorama accessories under the brand name Hobby Gear.



Steve's Excellent Adventure at the iHobby Show

This last October, I had the opportunity to be a 'presenter' at one of the nations premier hobby shows, the IHobby show at the Rosemont Convention Center for the Testors corporation. Through a mutual friend I was connected to one of the product development and marketing managers at Testors by the name of Adam Morrison. Adam was looking for a hobbyist that used and was familiar with their Aztec line of airbrushes and was willing to demo the airbrush at the show.



After a brief discussion of my long time use of Aztec airbrushes (I have several, an Aztec A430 hangs alongside my Paasche Model H single action in my spray booth) sealed the deal and I would use and present Aztec airbrushes to dealers and hobby store buyers on the first day of the show. I had a blast. Testors had a downdraft spray booth setup in one of their exhibit counters, air came from one their slick and extremely quite compressors, the AC500 with holding tank. I spent the day using their A470 dual action airbrush, demonstrating the ease of use and cleanup to a wide variety of users and non-users.

I became "Joe Airbrush User" to the crowd; I had a great time extolling the virtues of the

Testors airbrush. The best 'selling' feature of the Aztec airbrushes is the ease of cleanup for a dual action airbrush and economy of maintenance for the line. Many of my friends own Aztecs as well as other brands of dual action airbrushes such as Paasche V's Badgers, and Iwata's. We compare the amount of time spent spraying paint on a model, cleaning the brush between colors and final cleanup between the traditional dual actions and the Aztec, the Aztec always comes out ahead. Second, there are nine different spray nozzles for the Aztec line for acrylic and solvent based paints priced around \$13 retail so if the airbrush becomes unusable, an new nozzle gets you going again 99.9% of the time.

Who hasn't dropped their airbrush on floor and damaged the spray needle or metal nozzle? In this area the economies of the Aztecs shine through. When you forget to clean the airbrush, walk away to answer the phone or have a horrific clog because you try to use old paint, the Aztec nozzle can be disassembled and stripped down (Testors doesn't officially recommend it). Throw the disassembled parts into a small container of Super Clean (my favorite) or lacquer thinner (wear eye and hand protection with both is a must) for a thorough and complete cleaning. Believe me; I still have nozzles from my first Aztec that I still use today.

The best part of this adventure was talking with the show goers. I spoke at length with many hobby shop owners that carried airbrushes as a sideline to their paint lines but had never used or understood the differences between single and double action airbrushes.

It was a kick to put an Aztec in their hands for the first time and see their reaction. I spoke with one lady from Texas that builds models for customers at her store. I asked her what brand she uses and she replied Badger because a dealer gave her the brush long ago.

She used the Aztec and really liked it, I got her business card and Testors gladly sent her one of their Aztec brush sets. Did I have fun? Look for me at the Testors booth next year.
