

accompany building your next rat rod or vintage custom project, or just for cruising.







Historic Racing Miniatures is currently offering a Porsche 914-6 transkit. This will require a Fujimi Enthusiast series 911 kit to complete.






Also coming is a front-engined Scarab (w/engine!), which is rumored to be a complete kit, except for decals. VRM should be doing decals

including this Avenger GT-12 kit for his almost complete IMC kit collection.




And this Testors 39 Chevy prepainted metal body kit he is finishing up.




Chuck Herrmann: a 1987 Dodge Charger Shelby, an MPC kit built about 25 years ago.

John Walczak: a built 1/20 scale MPC AMX






Gerry Paquette: two 1/24 promos by Norscott, a 2014 Silverado and a 2015 Tahoe




And his completed MPC 1968 Firebird.



Gerry used the Replicas and Miniatures of Maryland resin six cyclinder endine to model a base model Firebird. It was wired and detailed.





Gerry had brought this in to some earlier meetings, he changed the color to Phoenician Yellow from his original dark green metallic.



There were a lot of extra details in the interior, including real wood veneer.



Moebius Dark Knight Batman and Bat-Pod Kit Build Ups

Since readers will be getting this issue just days before Halloween, I thought I would finally do my follow up on the Moebius Models Dark Knight Rises Batman figures and Bat-Pod since the figure in in costume.



These kits came out in 2012, the Bat-Pod motorcycle and the companion figures from the Dark Knight series of Batman movies. These were in an appreciated 1/25 scale. I finished up the Bat-Pod for some contests this summer.



The Bat Pod build was more challenging than expected. Mostly this was due to the unusual design, different than a standard motorcycle. Both rubber tires are huge. The driver actually lays down over the fuel tank to drive, and his knees rest on pads alongside the engine. The foot pedals are perpendicular and far to the rear. The handlebars attach to the fork on the bottom. So for much of the build it is hard to tell if you are proceeding correctly, or which way is front or rear! There are cannons and machine guns attached to the front fork.

Colors used were Testors Semi Gloss Black and Aluminum sprays with some flat black details

and wash. The driver figure is from the figure set. It took some realignment of the arms to get them to position accurately



Since it does not stand up by itself I drilled a hole on the bottom and used a paper clip to attach to a wood base.



The huge flowing cape from the figure hides much of the detail in back.



The figure set includes two figures, one driving as well as a standing pose. These are rather basic, about eight parts to assemble. The driver figure needs to be put together over the Bat Pod while in progress to assure everything lines up.

Overall I was pleased with the results. There were some areas that needed touch up due mistakes caused by my unfamiliarity with the unique design so follow the directions carefully. This is a nice addition to my Batstuff collection, again thanks to Moebius for issuing these in 1/25 scale to go along with my earlier Batman models.

IRON INVASION 2014
