

REAL WORLD AMC's Old Corporate HQ for \$500?

A corporate headquarters for \$500? That's what Wayne County MI set as the opening bid in a tax foreclosure auction for the former American Motors Corp.'s once-stately headquarters on Plymouth Road in Detroit. A measly \$500. Oh yes, and payment of \$232,000 in back taxes. There was one winning bidder, but the deal fell through when he missed the payment deadline.

Unlike the Packard Motor Car complex that lies in ruins and has become world-famous as a backdrop for the city's woes, AMC's office tower complex still looks as grand as it did in 1927 when it opened – at least at first glance. Closer inspection reveals the site has become a dumping ground, and scrappers and thieves have taken their toll, especially at the rear factory section where refrigerators and helicopters once were assembled.

AMC never built cars at the location; its assembly line was in Kenosha, WI, where the former Chrysler Corp., which acquired AMC in 1987, also produced engines until 2011. Although AMC moved its corporate offices to a modern glass-and-steel skyscraper in nearby Southfield in 1975, it continued to use the Plymouth Road complex to design and engineer trucks and SUVs, as did Chrysler after acquiring AMC. As part of the federal bailout in 2009 that saw Fiat SpA take over the former automaker, the property was designated as part of unwanted "old" Chrysler and put up for sale. What's now Fiat Chrysler Automobiles (FCA) in 2009 transferred 1,500 employees to Chrysler's Auburn Hills Technical Center north of Detroit, ending all operations on Plymouth Road.

Because a qualified bidder has not been found, ownership is expected to revert to the City of Detroit. But what can it do with the sprawling 1.4-million-sq.-ft. (130,064-sq.-m) facility, which stretches over 54 acres (18 ha) and is in a neighborhood that saw its best days long ago?

2016 GTR Club Project






The Aston Martin DB5 remains the most iconic of all the 007 cars.





How to Make Rust from Steel Wool

Some years ago I used to exchange e-mail with Vegard Henenger, who lived in Scandinavia. He was a fine model builder and passed on to me a formula for making "real" rust from Steel Wool. And in photo #1 you see what I started with.



Start with a fine grade of steel wool. In this case I used #0000. Pick a container that you can throw away when the process is completed, as there is quite a bit of rusty residue in the container when the process is finished. Put a number of small amounts of steel wool in the container, and add water so that the steel wool is submerged in it. Lastly, add salt as this speeds up the process of turning the steel wool into rust.



Photo #2 shows the container after the steel wool has been soaking for several days. (I think putting the container under a hot light or heat lamp would speed up the water evaporation, but haven't tried that, myself.)



Photo #3 shows the container with the steel wool almost completely dried out. Then photo #4 shows the container and the wood dowel rod I used to smash the rusted steel wool into a powder form. The red arrow points to the steel wool, now in powder form, in the lower left hand corner of the container.



Next, I placed the rusty powder into another container, added Elmer's Glue and water, to put the rust into a semi-liquid state. Then I use an old paint brush to apply the rust to my modeling subject.

For this article, I used a piece of styrene card stock and gave it several coats of acrylic black. Then I applied the semi-liquid rust with an old brush. In photos #5 and #6 you see the results of that application.



The final picture, photo #7 shows a styrene set of steps with platform I fabricated in approx. 1:20th scale for a figure composition. The individual steps were fashioned from brass screen.



George Barris



George Barris was known throughout the world as the 'original' King of Kustomizers. His creations are legendary in the world of television and motion pictures including the likes of the original television series Batmobile, Munster Koach, Beverly Hillbillies, KITT from Nightrider and more! His personal Star Collection includes the General Lee, Starsky & Hutch Torino, Green Hornet and Monkee Mobile.

Following is a summary from his official website: www.barris.com

George was born in Chicago in the mid twenties. In 1928, he and his older brother Sam moved to Roseville, California with relatives after their parents died. They both were excellent students especially in drama, music and drawing. George pursued a passion for building scratchbuilt aircraft models which led to model cars. He won competitions for construction and design. Eventually they moved up to real cars. The family gave the brothers a 1925 Buick in need of repair for the work they did at their restaurant. This Buick became the first "Barris Brothers" custom car. The old Buick needed much attention and their creative urges to make it different took hold. They straightened the body and added bolt-on accessories before George hand painted the car in orange with blue stripes. It was promptly sold to purchase a 1929 Model A and he never stopped.

After Sam entered WW II, George moved to Los Angeles where his talents began to flourish. He soon opened his first shop in Bell, a Los Angeles suburb in late 1944. Sam joined him after his discharge in 1945. They opened a new shop on Compton Ave. in Los Angeles. The shop was known as the "Barris Brother's Custom Shop". Sam's natural metal craftmanship served as a perfect foil to George's desire to design, paint, manage, and promote. George also began photographing autos professionally and writing for car magazines. He was able to promote his business by demonstrating their techniques

through how-to articles. The Barris brothers outgrew their shop on Compton and moved to a larger shop in Lynwood where the famous Hirohata Merc was born. Sam bought a new two-door Mercury and knew it would make a great custom. He figured it out all in his head and began cutting it up and reformed the car. Bob Hirohata admired Sam's style and brought in his '51 Merc for a full custom job. Sam finished his car so it could be shown at the 1952 Motorama. It turned out to be the sensation of the show.




The movie studios had taken note of Barris customs on the streets and at races and came to George for cars for their films. One of the first films Barris made cars for was called "High School Confidential". The success of the initial movie car venture motivated George to seek business in Hollywood. This included customizing the personal cars of the stars as well. As the past forty plus years have shown, this association with the studios and stars has been long and fascinating.









In the late 50's Revell began making model kits of George's cars. AMT soon joined with the "Ala Kart." Plastic model kits became the biggest selling toys at the time.







Lots of the annual kits from the 60's featured customized versions designed by Barris.




The Ala-Kart has always been one of the favorite Barris kits, AMT has done two separate tools.









