IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL RM2012/019

REPLACEMENT OF THE REGULATOR RECTIFIER FOR STREET TRIPLE AND DAYTONA 675

Dear Triumph,

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act

VIN:

Triumph has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain model year 2006-2009 Street Triple, Street Triple R, and Daytona 675 motorcycles. The regulator/rectifier can overheat and prevent the motorcycle from charging. Once the battery is fully discharged, the motorcycle may stall. If the motorcycle stalls, there is an increased risk of a crash leading to personal injury.

To correct this condition, your dealer will replace the regulator rectifier. The service and parts will be provided free of charge. This work will take about ½ hour to complete however, additional time may be required depending on how dealer appointments are scheduled and processed. We urge you to contact your local Triumph dealer immediately to arrange an early appointment with the service department.

Federal regulations require that any vehicle lessor receiving this recall notice must forward a copy of this notice to the lessee within ten days.

If you had this repair performed before you received this letter, you may be eligible to receive reimbursement for the cost of obtaining a pre-notification remedy of the problem associated with this recall.
