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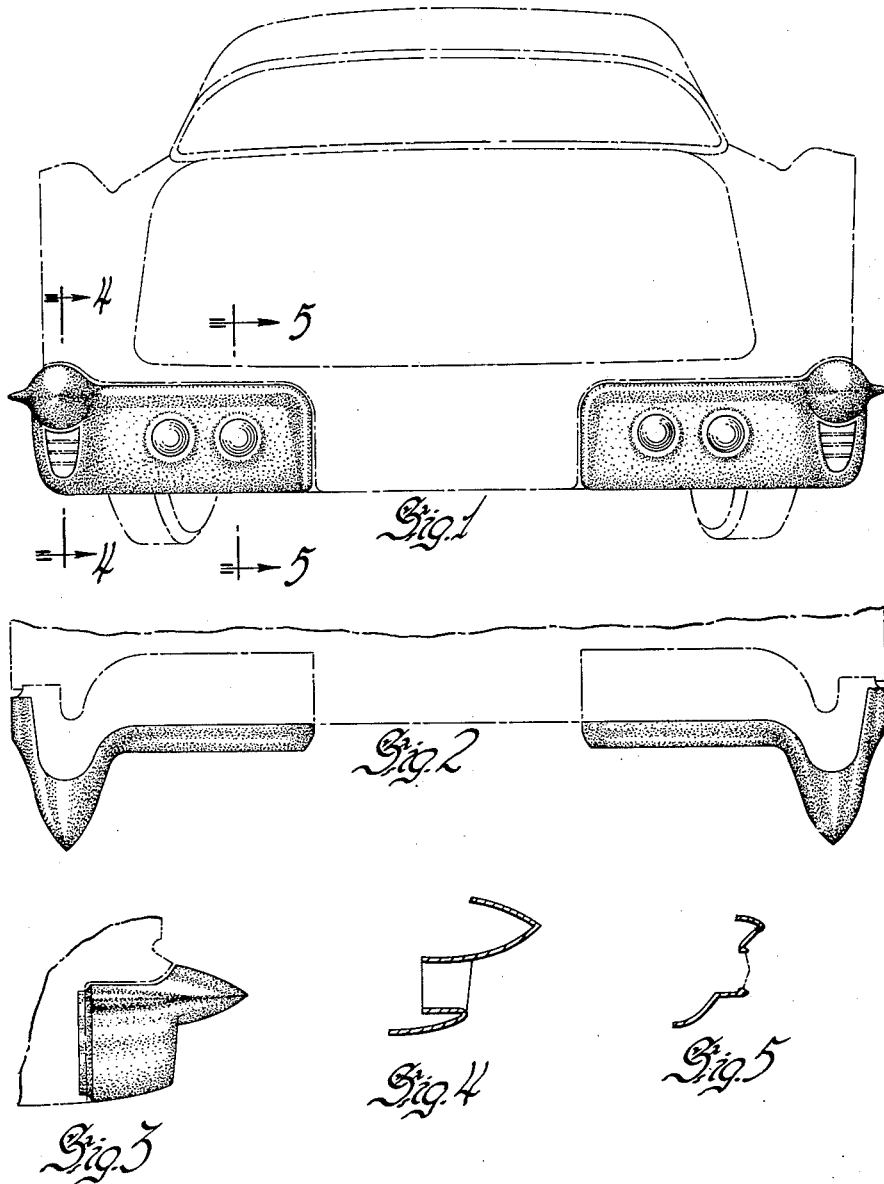
## AUTOMOBILE

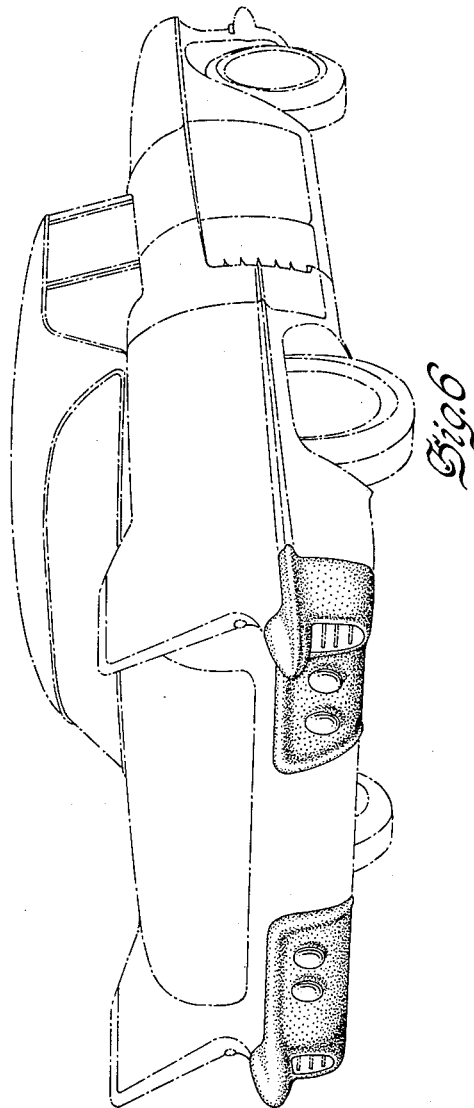


Figure 1 is a rear elevational view of an automobile embodying our new design;  
Figure 2 is a partial top plan view of the rear portion of the automobile of Figure 1;  
Figure 3 is a side elevational view of that portion of the automobile shown in Figure 2;  
Figure 4 is a sectional view on the plane indicated by line 4—4 of Figure 1; and  
Figure 5 is a sectional view on the plane indicated by line 5—5 of Figure 1.  
Figure 6 is a rear perspective view of the automobile of Figure 1 taken from the right hand side thereof.  
The dominant features of our design reside in the full

line portions of the drawings. The front of the automobile is of conventional configuration.
