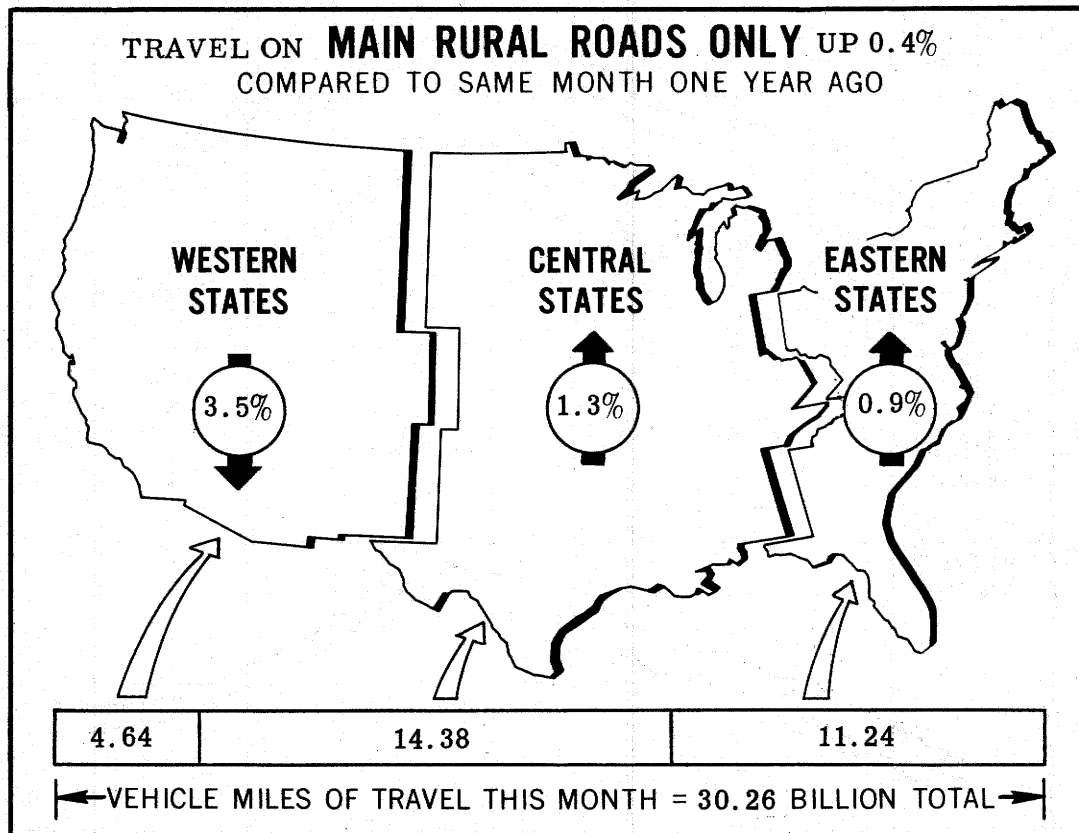

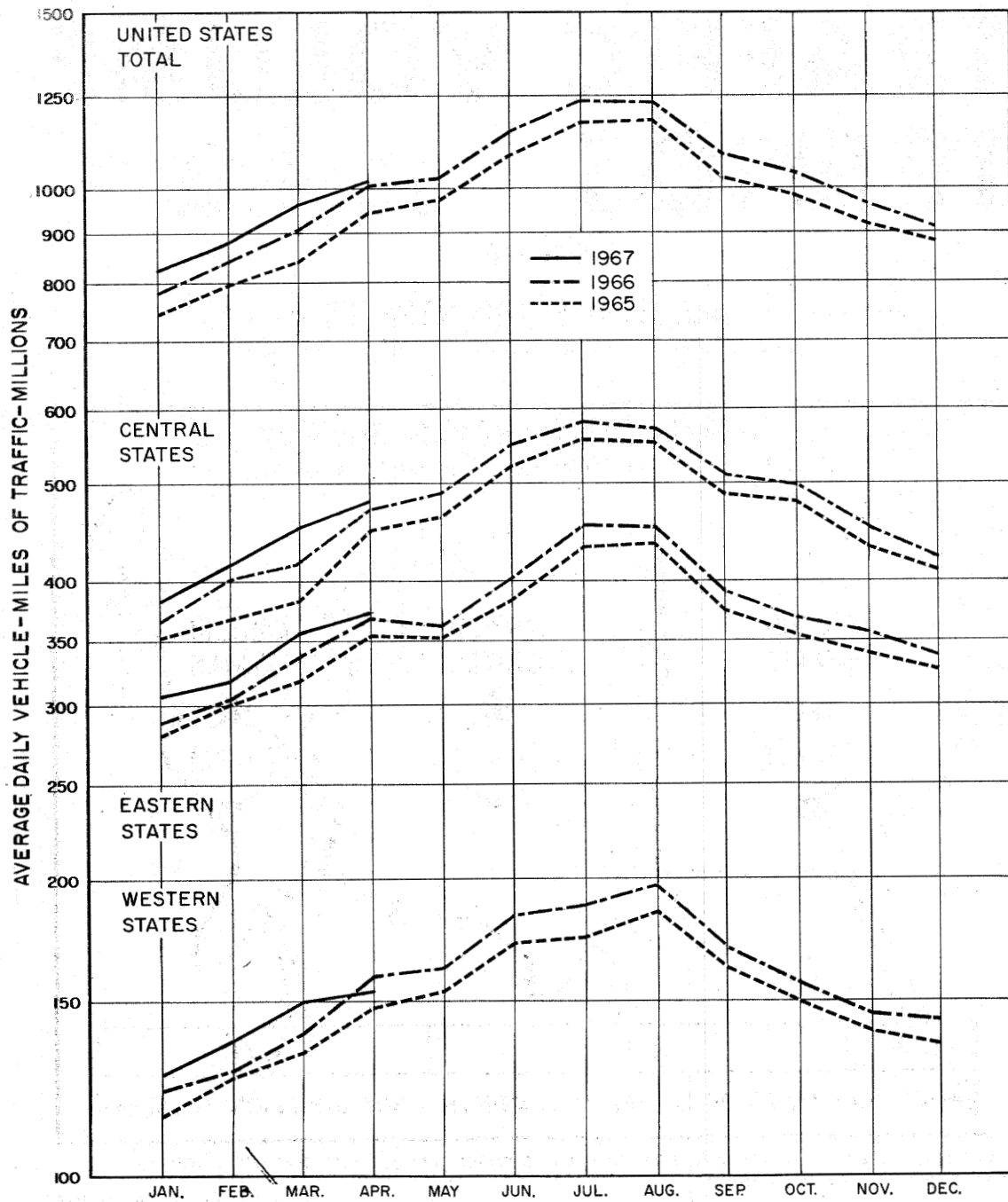


FIGURE 1—TRAVEL ON MAIN RURAL ROADS, BY MONTHS

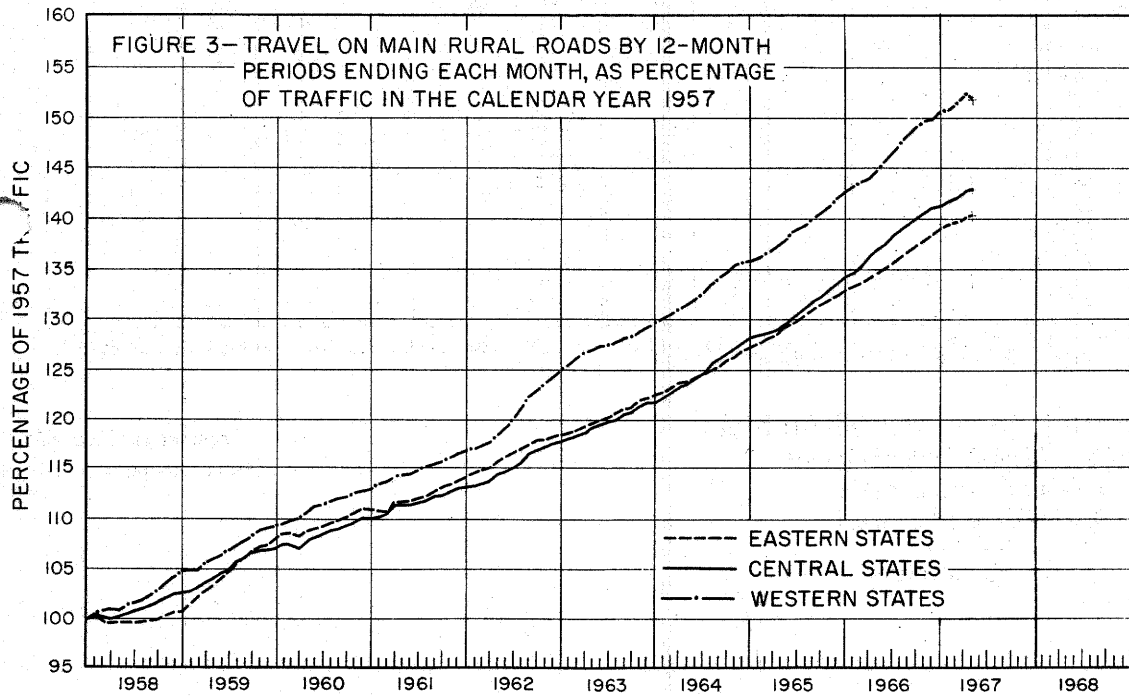
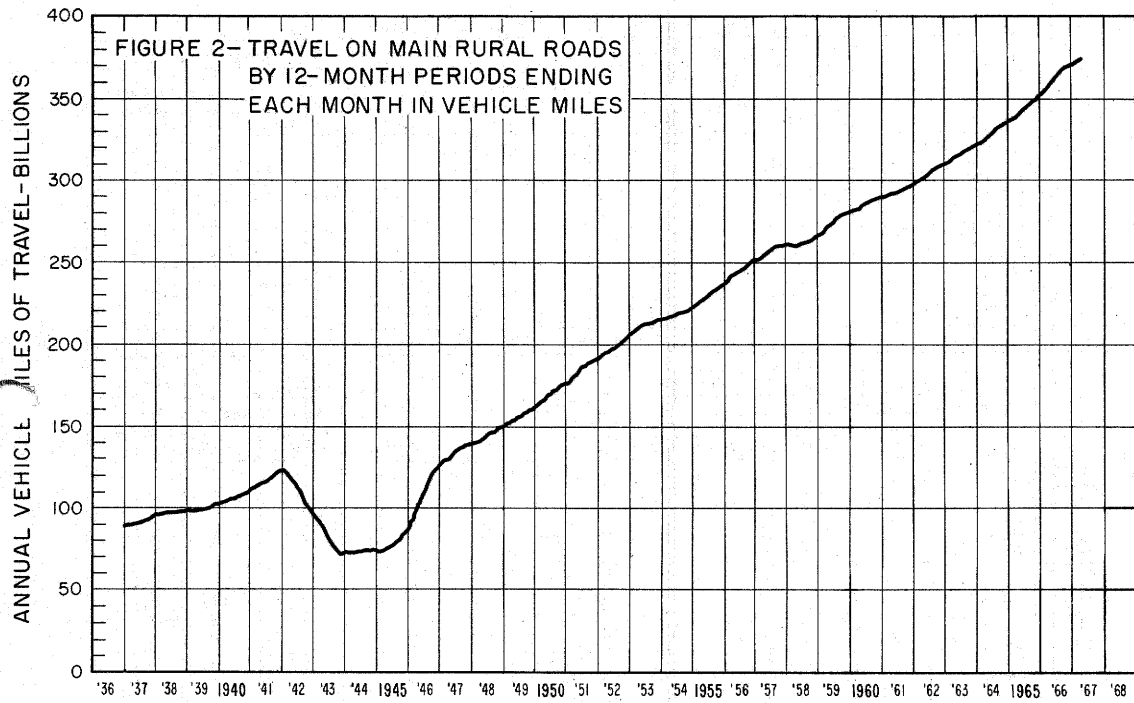
