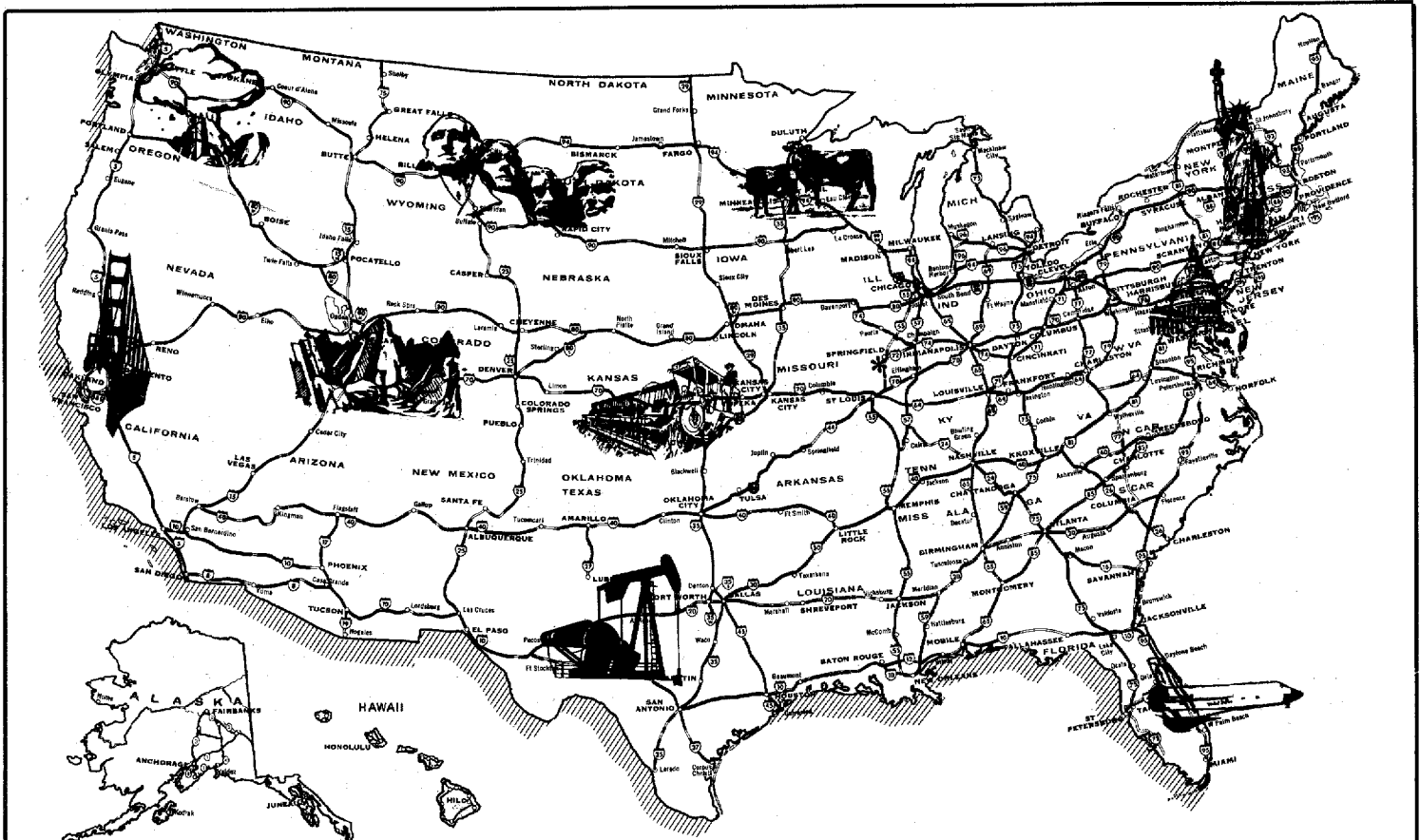


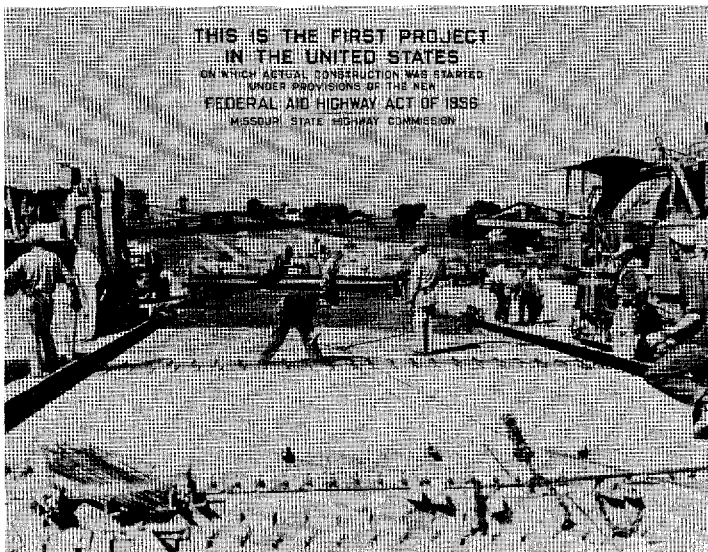

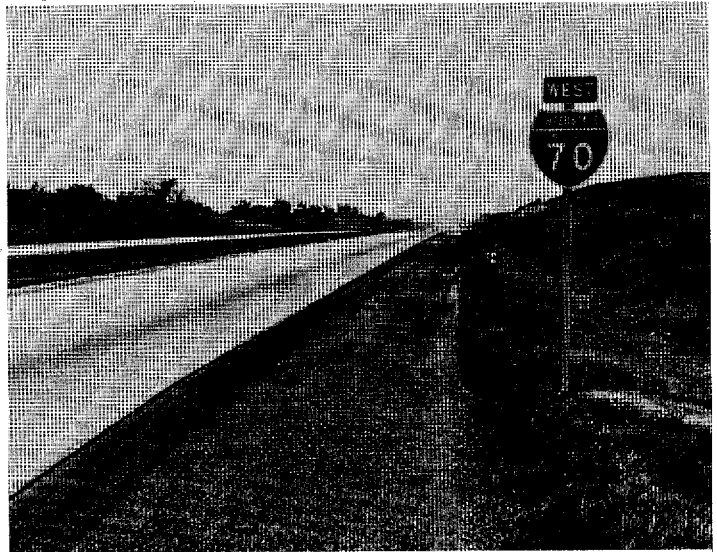

SELECTED HIGHWAY STATISTICS & CHARTS -- 1980

MOTOR FUEL

Highway use of motor fuel in 1980 decreased by 5.9 percent from 1979 and is expected to decrease by 2.7 percent in 1981 from 1980 levels. Motor-fuel revenues, down 2.1 percent in 1980 from 1979, are expected to increase by about 4 percent since almost 50% of the states increased their tax rates during the year.

The decreases in fuel usage occurred even though motor fuel was readily available in 1981; prices were stable to somewhat lower than in 1980 and travel was up. The decrease was due, at least in part, to the continuing increases in the fuel efficiency of the vehicle fleet --- 1976, 12.20 miles per gallon (mpg); in 1977, 12.32 mpg; in 1978, 12.38; in 1979, 12.52; and in 1980, 13.23 mpg.

MOTOR VEHICLE REGISTRATIONS

Motor vehicle registrations in the Nation increased from 151,869,299 in 1979 to 155,889,692 in 1980, an increase of 2.6 percent. Motor vehicle revenues increased 3 percent. It is estimated that 1981 registrations will exceed 1980 by 1.02 percent for a total of 159,760,000.

DRIVER LICENSING

The 145.3 million total licensed drivers in 1980 reflects a 1.4 percent increase over 1979, and a 1.8 percent increase is expected in 1981. The rate of increase seems to be slowing somewhat, perhaps due to a declining birth rate since the late 1950's and a saturation of the driving-age population. In 1980, 82.8 percent persons 15 and over were licensed drivers.

The male portion of the drivers, 53.13 percent, increased 0.9 percent, while the female segment increased by 2.0 percent over 1979. Drivers aged 24 years and under make up 21.01 percent of the total licensed drivers.

There was almost one driver per registered automobile, and each driver averaged 9,320 vehicle miles of travel.

HIGHWAY FINANCE

Highway-user imposts, consisting chiefly of motor-fuel and motor-vehicle taxes and tolls, provided about 58 percent of the total receipts for highways by all units of government in 1980. Total receipts amounted to \$38.6 billion, an increase of only 1.6 percent over 1979. This increase came solely from nonuser sources, up \$0.8 billion in 1980 over 1979. Roaduser revenue actually declined in 1980 - down \$0.2 billion from 1979.

Total highway expenditures exceeded \$41.0 billion, a 9.7 percent increase over 1979. Capital outlay amounted to \$19.9 billion or 48 percent of total expenditures, an increase of almost 13 percent over 1979. The construction price index, rose 20.4 points over the 1977 base year, or 14.3 percent over 1979. The Highway maintenance and operation index rose 16 points or 13.8 percent from 1979 to 1980, and is more than one third greater than the 1977 base year.

At the State level, highway-user imposts contributed almost 80 percent of the total \$19.4 billion of State highway funds. Total State receipts for highways in 1980 increased 5 percent over 1979. State expenditures totaled almost \$26 billion in 1980, an increase of 12 percent over 1979. Capital outlay, up 16 percent over 1979, accounted for 59 percent of total expenditures.

ROADWAY MILEAGE AND HIGHWAY TRAVEL

Existing public roads and streets in the United States, as of December 31, 1980, totaled approximately 3.86 million miles.

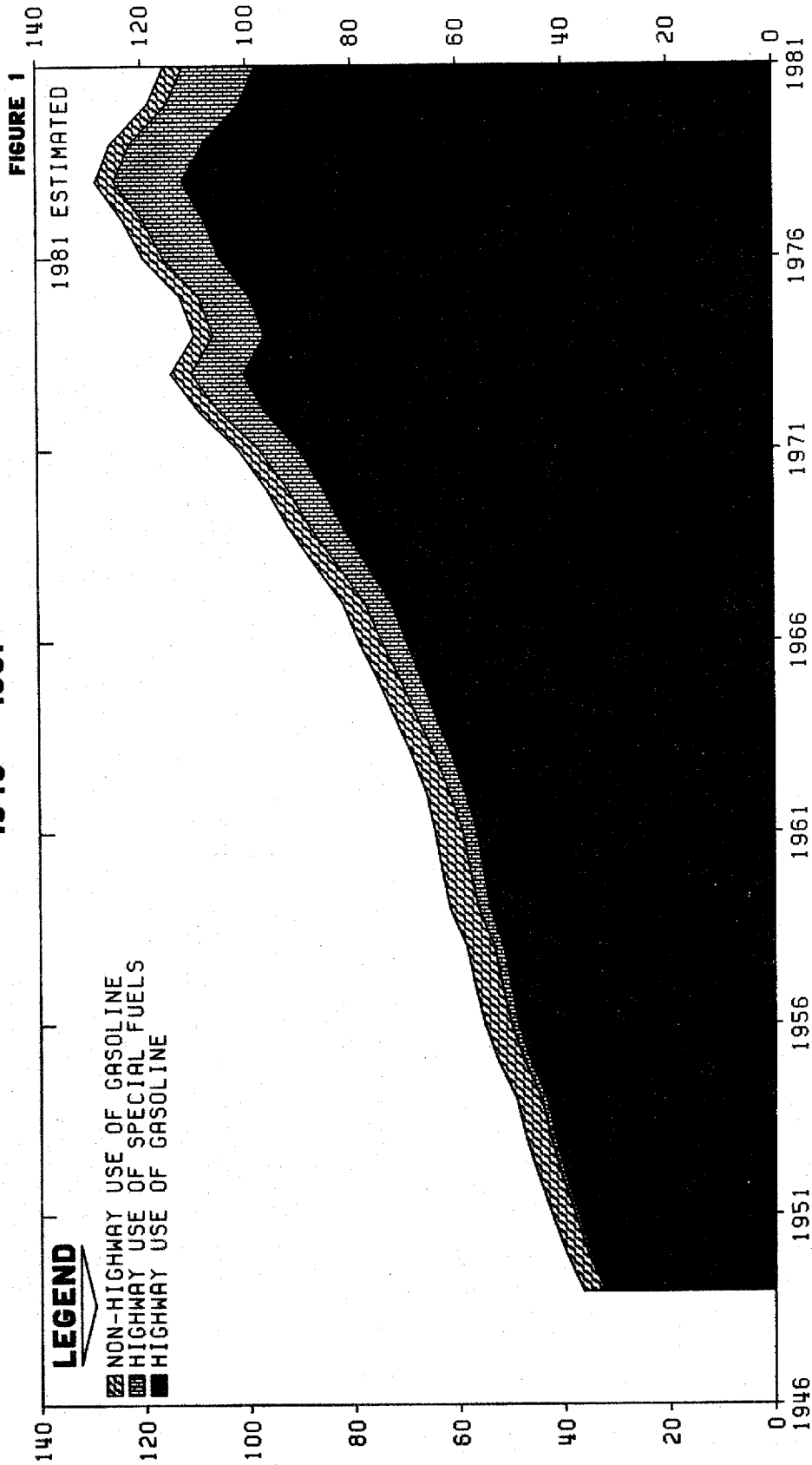
Highway travel in the United States has declined to an estimated 1,521 billion vehicle miles in 1980 -- a decrease of about one-half percent from the previous year.

The Interstate System accounts for about 1 percent of the Nation's total route mileage and carries 19 percent of the travel. The arterial class highways (including Interstate) represent 10 percent of the mileage and carry 69 percent of the travel. All arterial and collector highways combined, which include 31 percent of the Nation's mileage, carry 86 percent of the travel.

MICELLANEOUS

Expenditures per mile average \$19,253 and \$5,148 per mile for capital outlay and maintenance respectively, compared to 12.45 per 1,000 vehicle-miles-of-travel and 121.49 per registered vehicle. Some of the variations among States may be easier to visualize by considering total road and street miles per 1,000 persons, with the most populous States exceeding 60 miles per 1,000 persons.

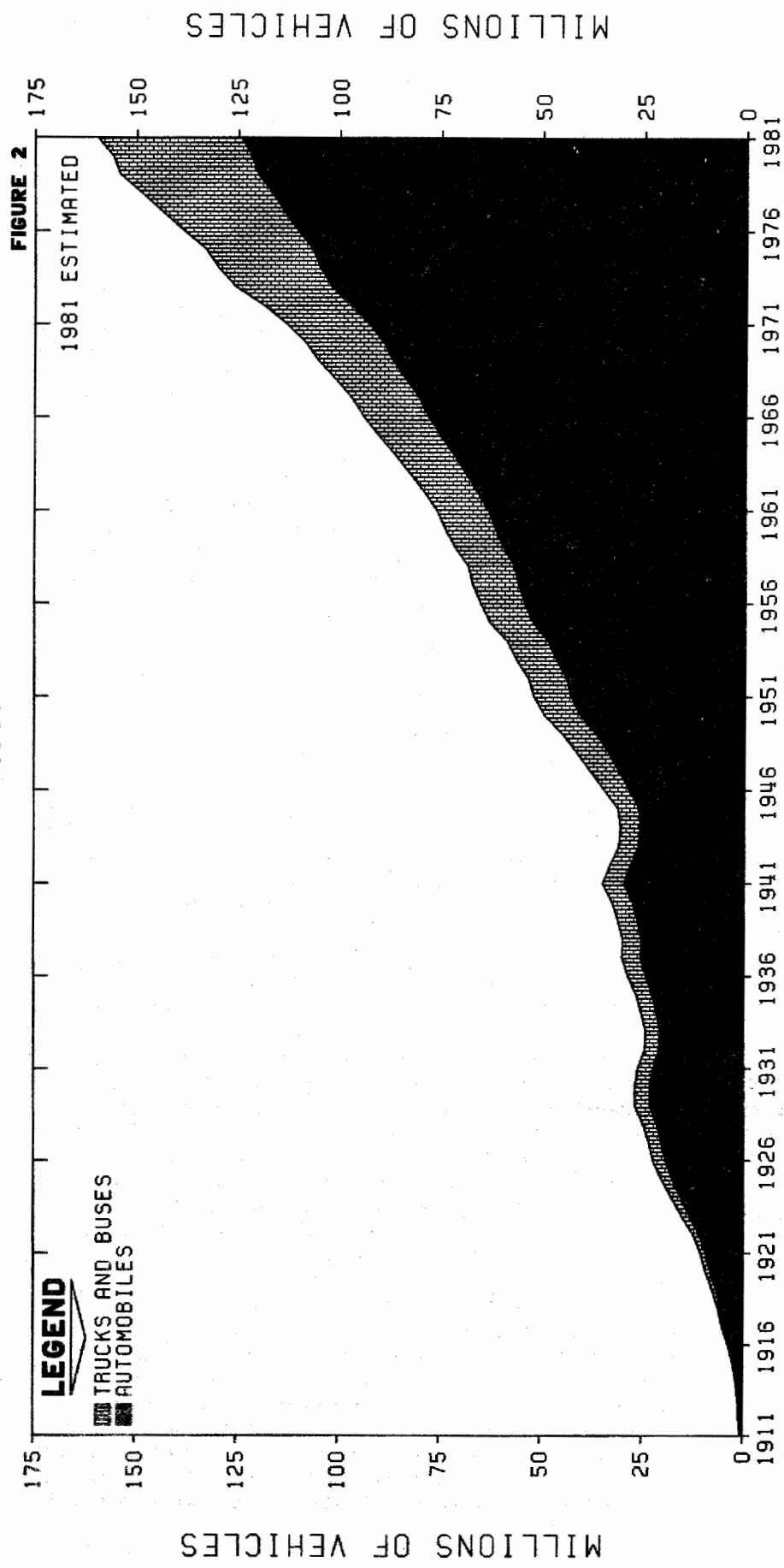

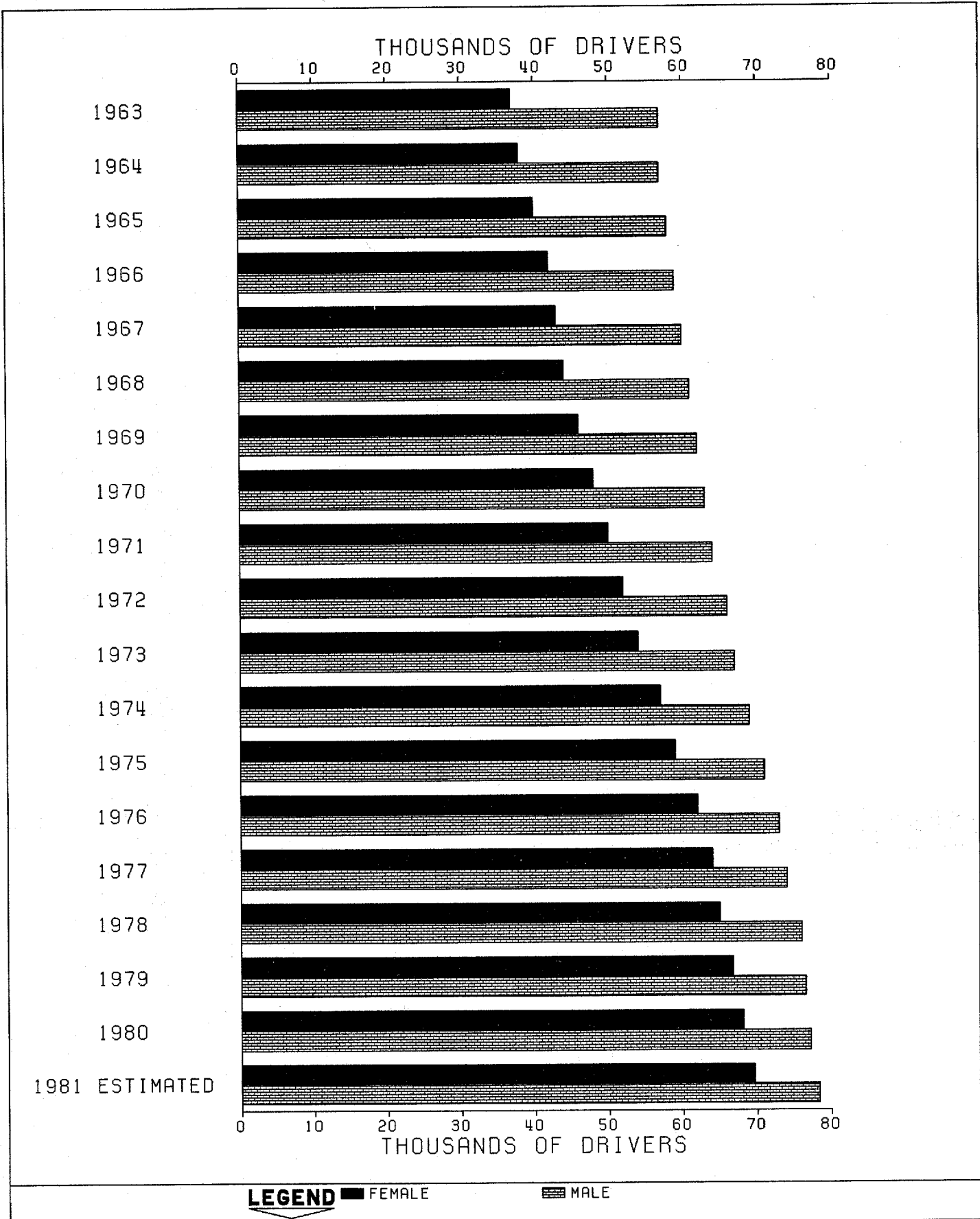

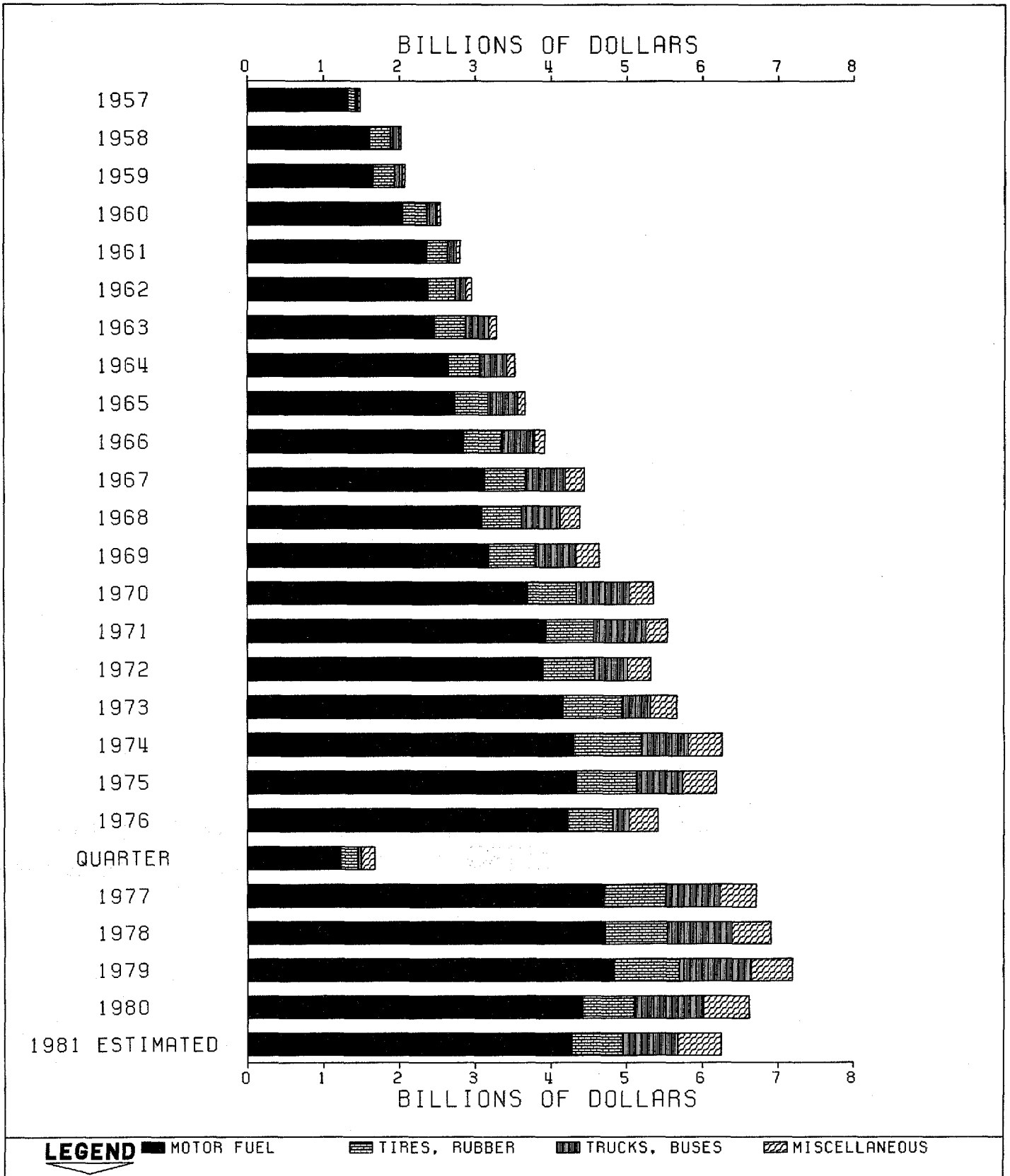

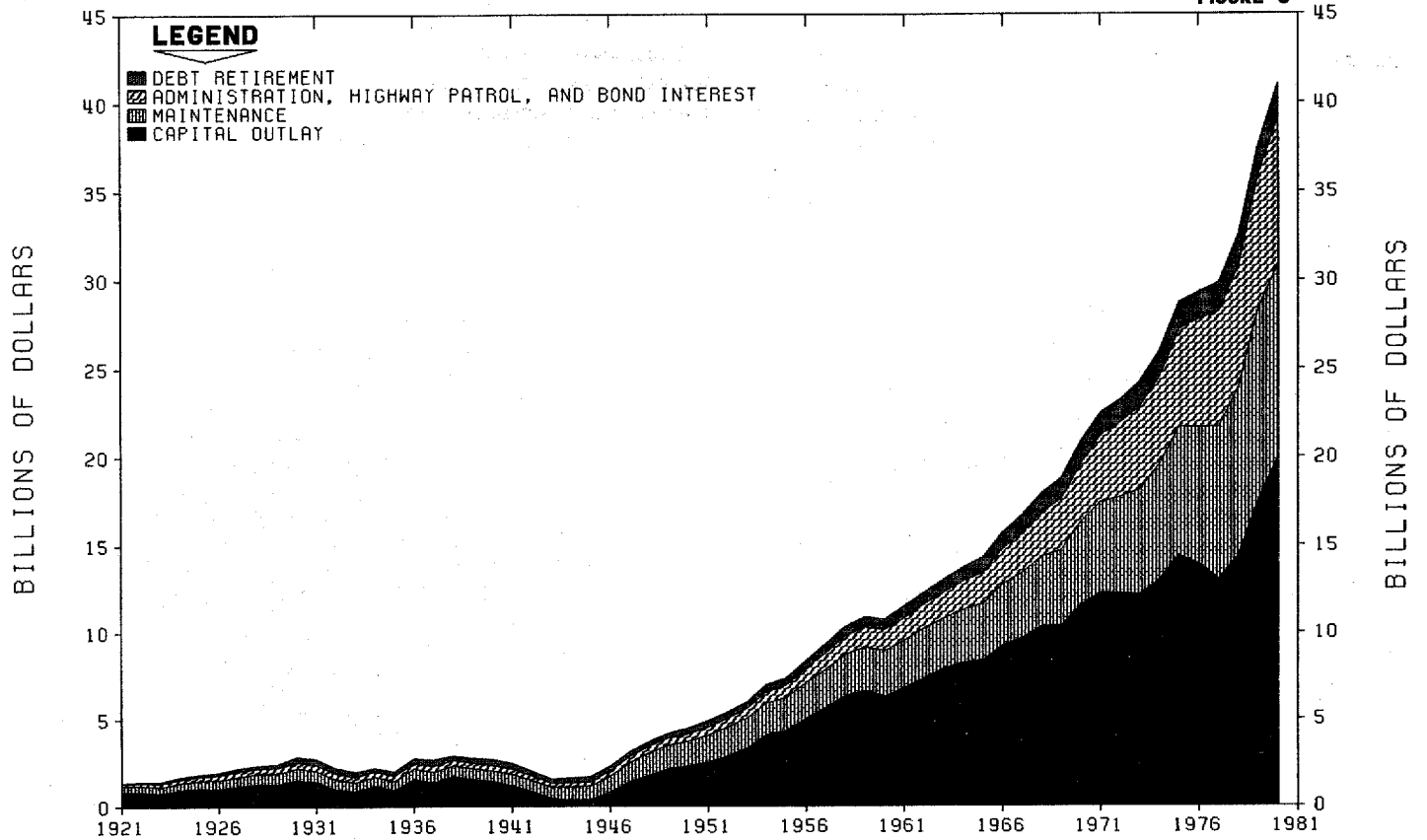
TOTAL RECEIPTS FOR HIGHWAYS, BY GOVERNMENTAL UNITS 1921 - 1980

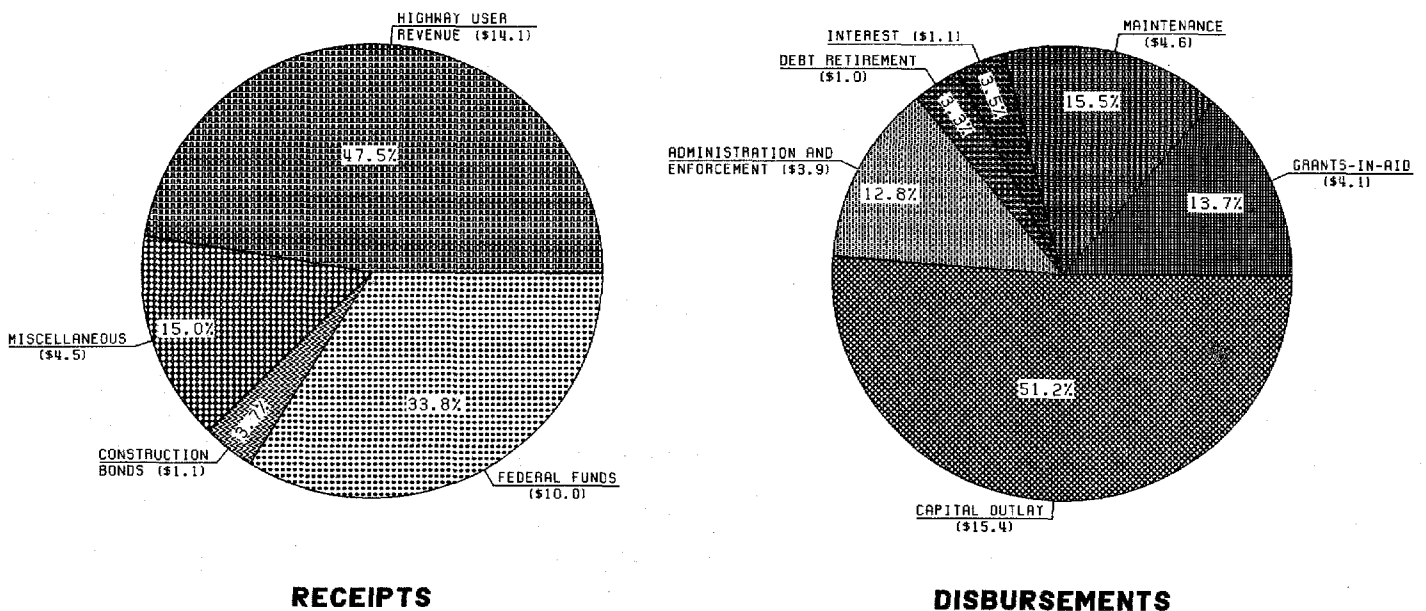

STATE RECEIPTS AND DISBURSEMENTS FOR HIGHWAYS 1980 (IN BILLIONS OF DOLLARS)



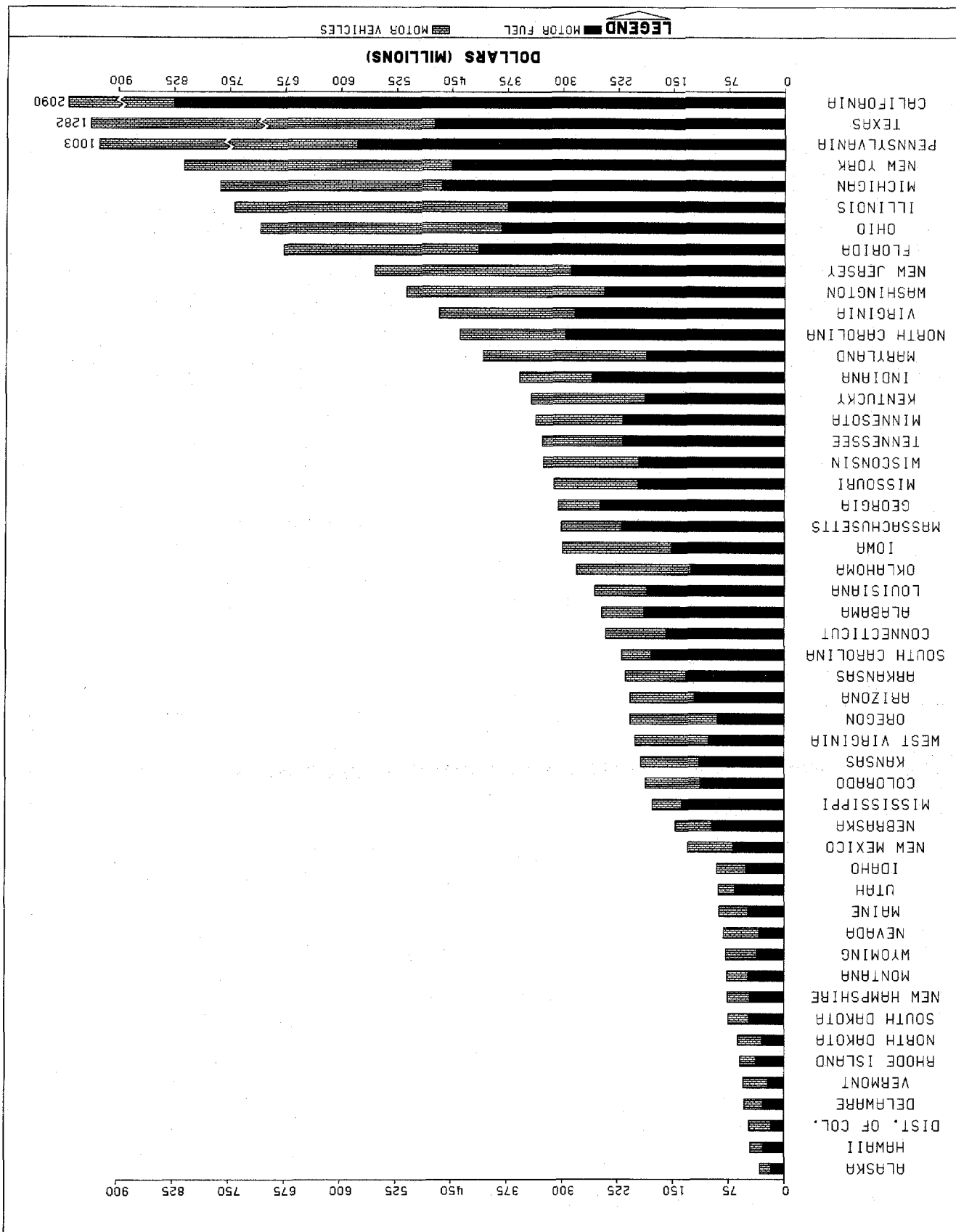

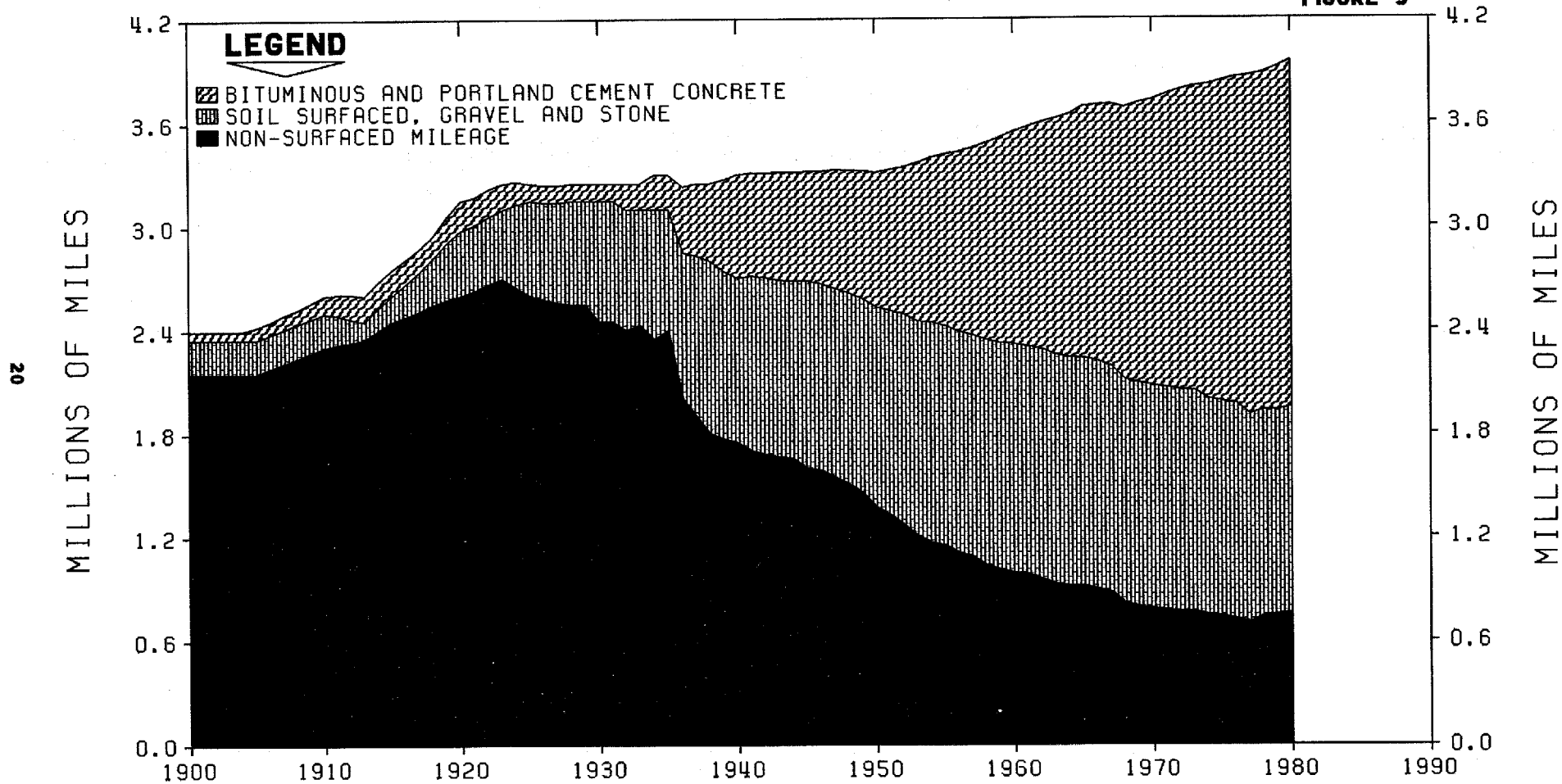

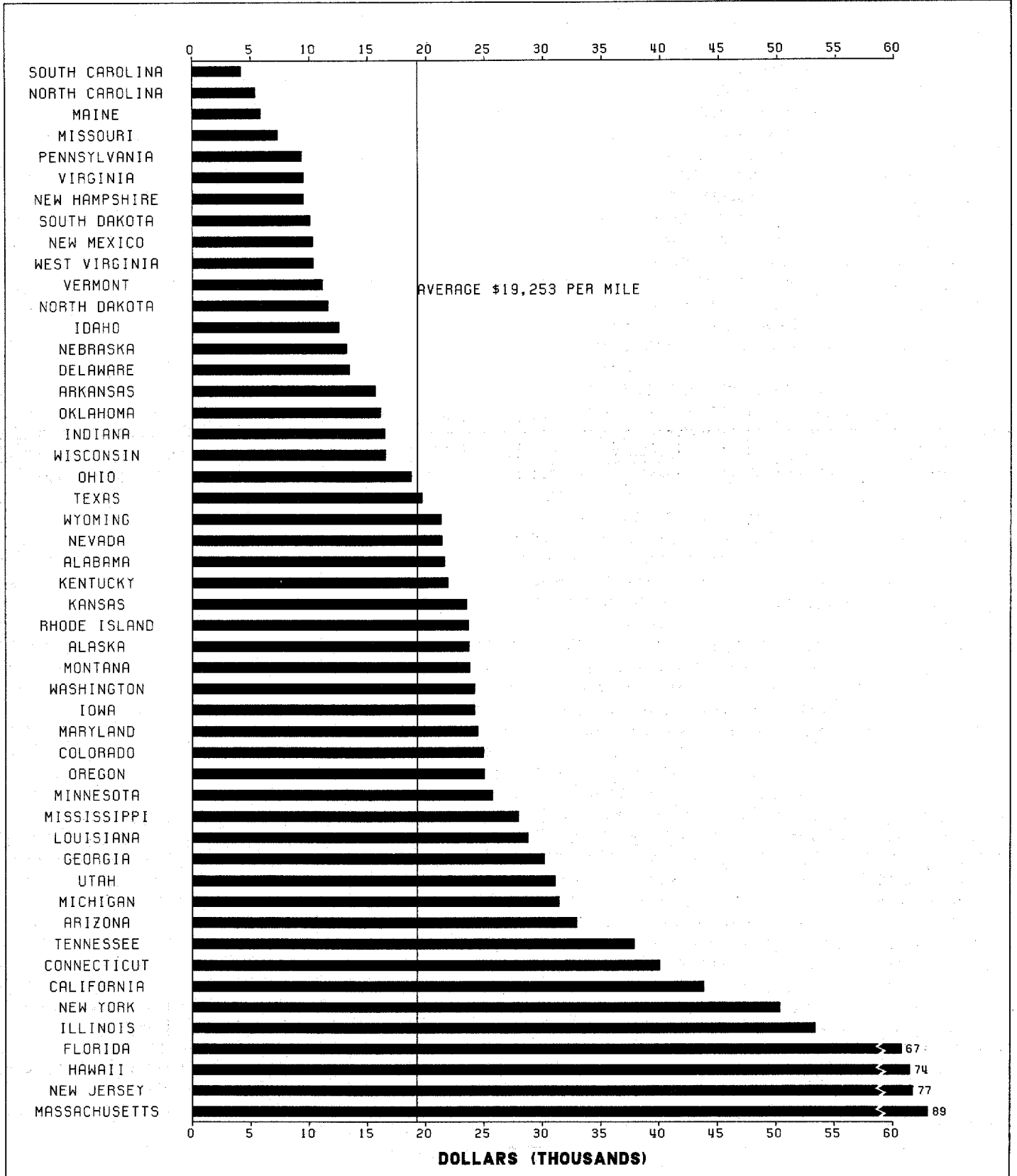

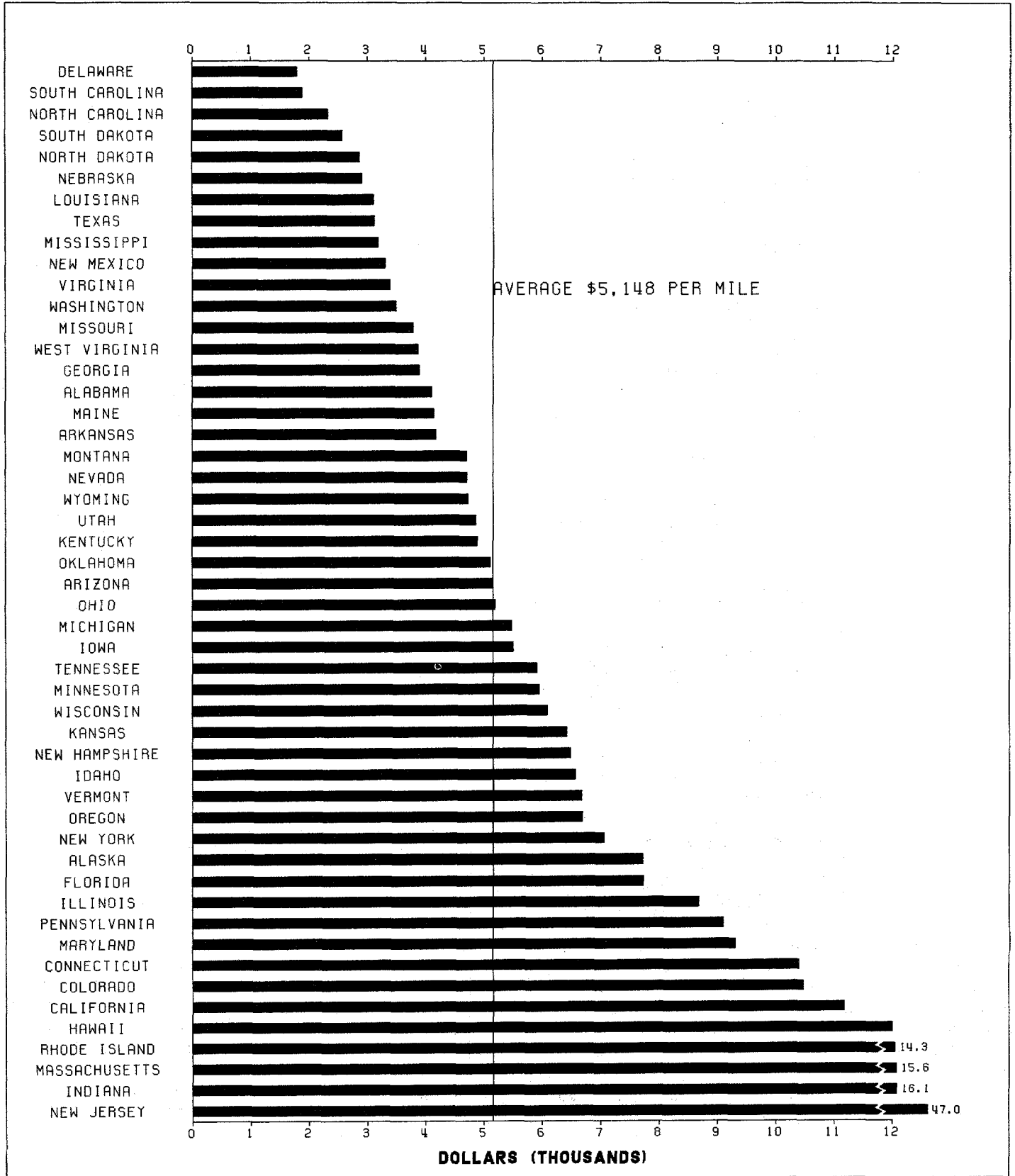

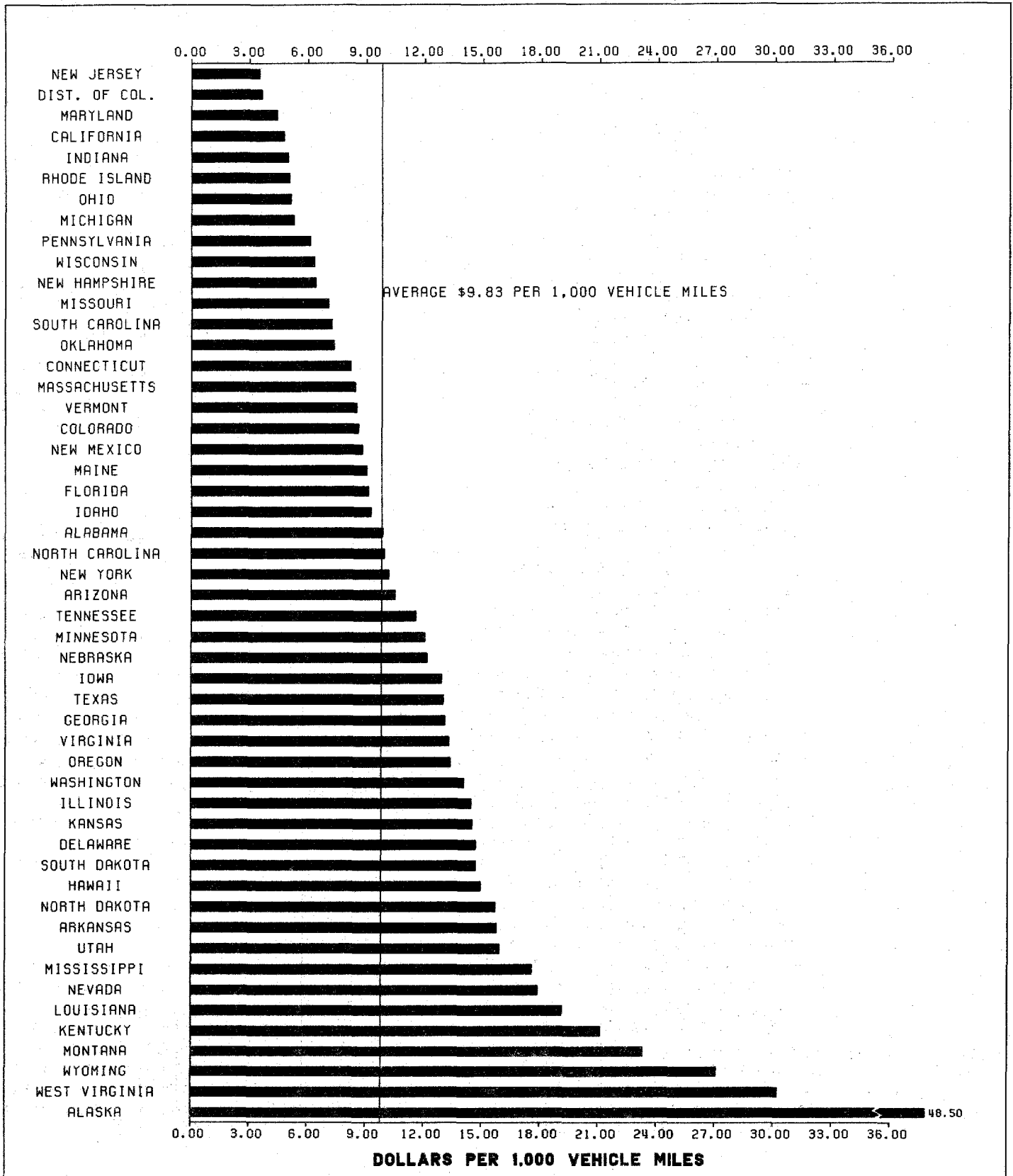

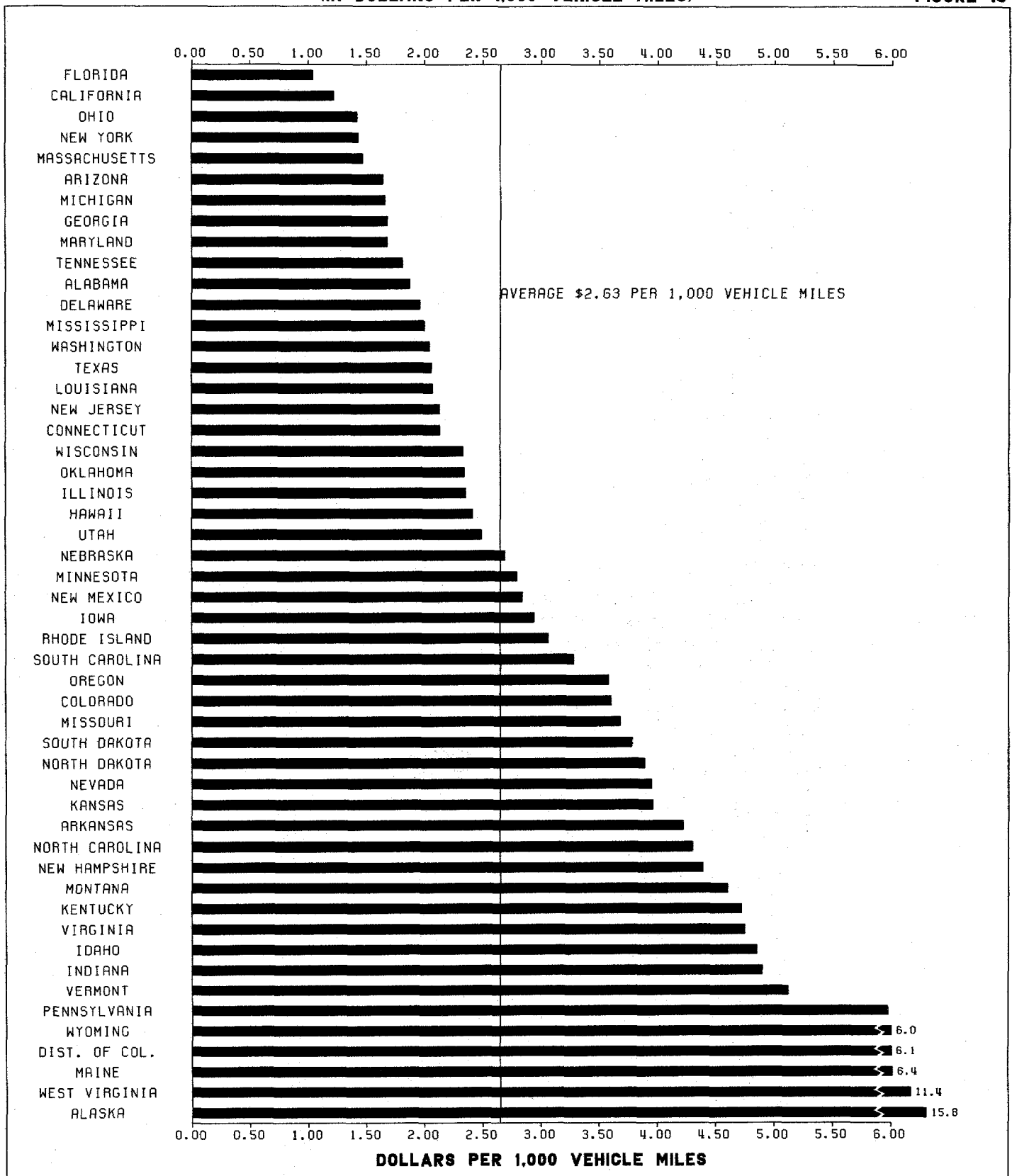
**STATE EXPENDITURES PER VEHICLE MILE OF TRAVEL

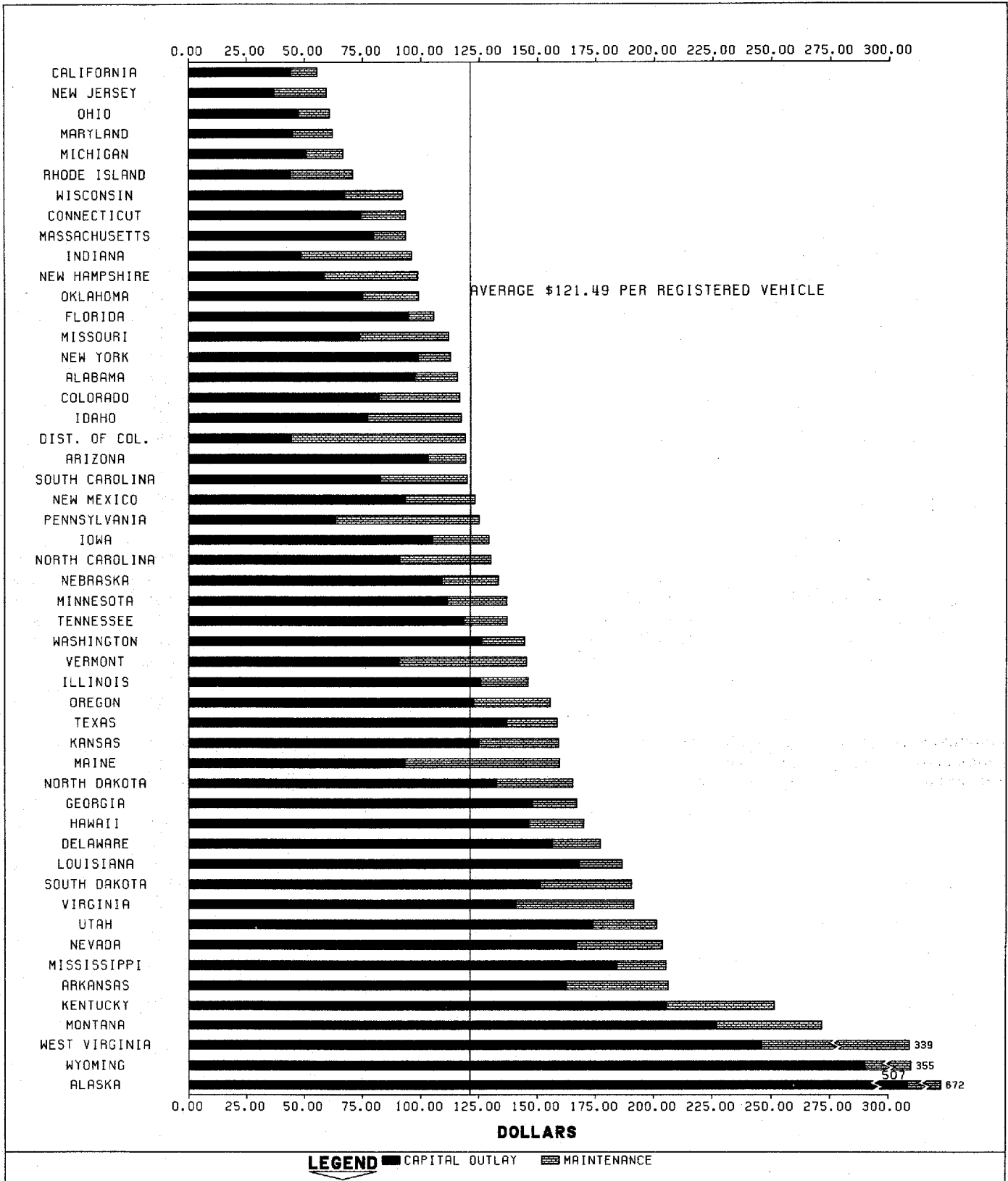

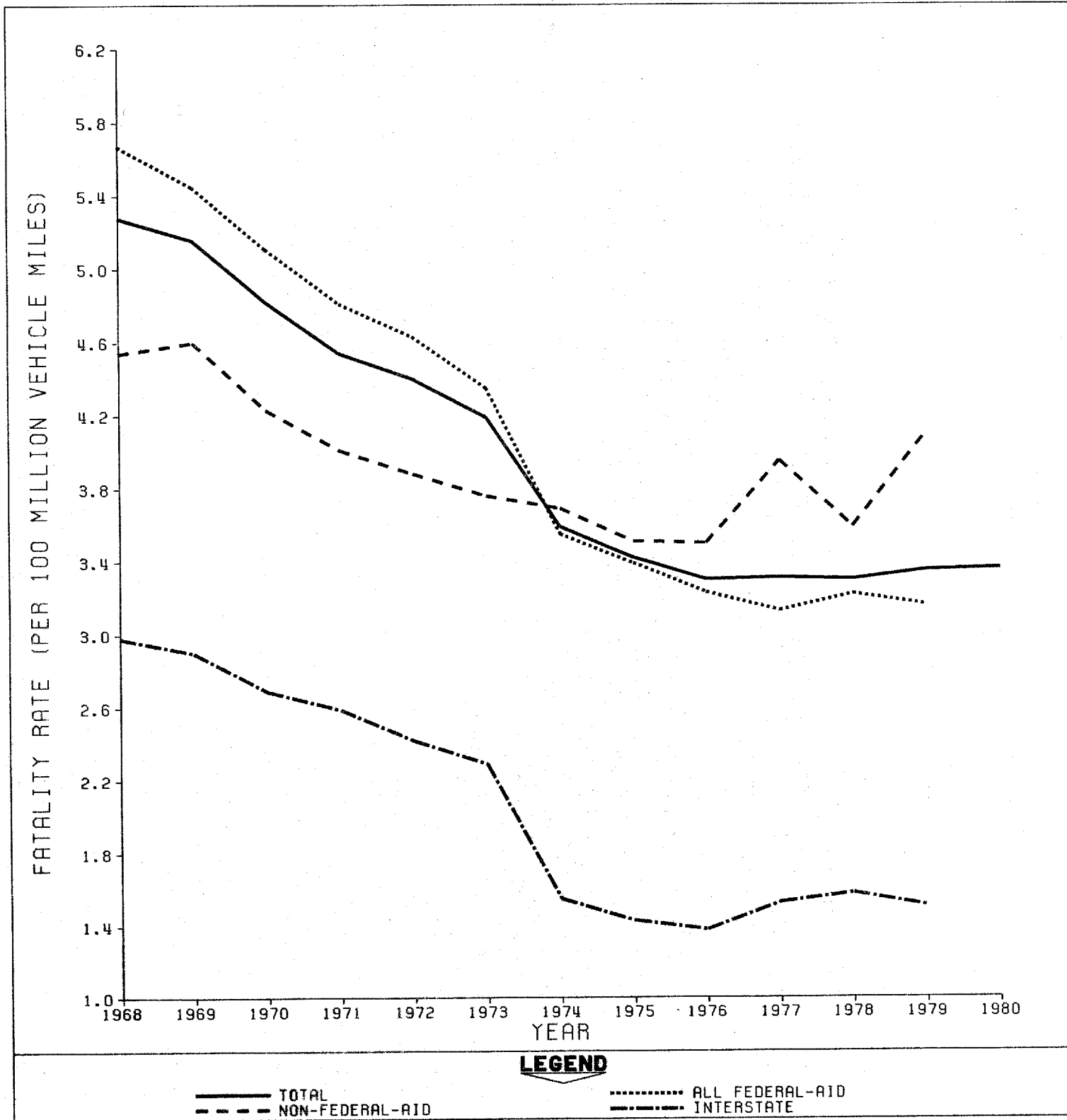
