No On-Street Parking on the Newly Reconstructed Canal Street in Carlsbad

As the newly reconstructed Canal Street nears completion, the New Mexico Department of Transportation would like to remind motorists that there is no longer on-street parking on this section of Canal Street.

As part of the public involvement/preliminary design process, it was decided to eliminate the on-street parking so that medians/left turn lanes could be installed as part of the reconstruction. This will allow for motorists to make left turns at the intersections without blocking the through traffic.

The New Mexico Department of Transportation and the Contractor, James Hamilton Construction Company out of Silver City, thank the citizens of Carlsbad for their patience during the reconstruction of Canal Street.

Again, as a reminder, motorists are asked not to park on Canal Street as there are no longer any on-street parking spaces.
