N.M. 532 (Ski Run Road) in Lincoln County Now Open to Traffic

Lincoln County – N.M. 532 (Ski Run Road) in Lincoln County is now open to traffic – after being closed due to the Little Bear Fire in early June. The New Mexico Department of Transportation and U.S. Forrest Service closed the road due to damage to the roadway from the Little Bear Fire.

Repair work will continue on the road into the fall, with intermittent, short-term closures to repair areas of the roadway as needed due to flooding and erosion.

The opening is welcome news for local residents and motorists, along with visitors to the Ski Apache and the White Mountain Wilderness recreational area. Motorists are urged to use extra caution when traveling along this route.
