U.S. Hwy 64 Chip Seal Work To Begin Near Dulce

The New Mexico Department of Transportation will begin chip seal work southwest of Dulce on Monday, September 10. The chip seal crew will be working on U.S. Highway 64 from mile marker 123 to mile marker 115, near the historic Project Gasbuggy site.

Motorists may encounter single lane closures with a flagging operation and pilot car escort between the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Minor delays should be expected when chip seal work is underway. Weather permitting, the project will be completed by Thursday, September 13.
