Crack-sealing work on N.M. 48 began this week in Lincoln County

COUNTY: Lincoln County

HIGHWAY: N.M. 48

CLOSEST CITY: Ruidoso

START DATE: Monday, December 3, 2012

END DATE: Monday, December 17, 2012

PROJECT: The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) will be filling pavement cracks on N.M. 48 in Lincoln County near Ruidoso. The \$170,000 project will prolong the life of the highway. All work is expected to be complete by the end of the month.

WORK: Other roads scheduled for crack-sealing work in the area include U.S. 380.

TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS: Single-lane closures can be expected during the duration of this project. Hours of operation are from 7:00 a.m. to 5:30 p.m., seven days a week. Please drive safely through construction zones.
