NMDOT invites public input on First Street (U.S. 285) ADA Enhancement Project on Thursday, February 28, in Artesia

Artesia – The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) will be holding a public information meeting on Thursday, February 28, at Artesia City Hall, 511 West Texas, in Artesia to discuss an ADA enhancement project scheduled along First Street (U.S. 285) from Hermosa Drive to Richey Avenue.

An Open House will be held from 6:00 to 7:30 p.m. The public meeting will provide an opportunity for the public to meet with NMDOT staff and ask questions about plans for the ADA enhancement work. Enhancement work will include minor geometric modifications, ADA ramps and other miscellaneous work to bring intersections in ADA compliance.
