N.M. 532 Chip Seal Work to Begin Today in Lincoln County

The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) will begin chip seal operations on Tuesday, September 3, on N.M. 532 (Ski Run Road) in Lincoln County. The project includes approximately 12 miles of resurface work that will preserve the life of the highway.

Other roads chip sealed this summer include N.M. 244, N.M. 6563 (Sunspot Road), U.S. 70, N.M. 48, and N.M. 220.

During the project motorists can expect a full road closure Monday thru Friday. Work is expected to be complete in two weeks, weather permitting. Drivers are asked to watch for NMDOT maintenance personnel working in the area, observe temporary construction signing, and reduce speed to the posted speed limits.
