NM 229 Pavement Rehabilitation Work to begin in Eddy County

Artesia – The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) District Two will begin a project to rehabilitate pavement on NM 229 in Eddy County.

The work will begin in Eddy County on Tuesday, April 15th along NM 229 to the junction of US 82.

Drivers will encounter flaggers where work is being performed, as well as a single lane closure. During the project motorists can expect delays between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. Motorists are asked to seek an alternate route while work is taking place. The project should be complete by the end of the month, weather permitting.
