Traffic Signal and ADA Improvements Scheduled This Week in Clovis

Clovis – A new traffic signal and Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) improvements are scheduled to begin this week at the intersection of Llano Estacado and Thornton Streets in Clovis. The new traffic signal will include upgrades at the intersection to include ADA compliant sidewalk ramps, pavement markings and permanent signing.

The goal is for the signal to be operational this summer, weather permitting. Stop signs may be in place in all directions during installation. Motorists can expect brief delays.
