

Albuquerque (May 30, 2014) – Traffic Report

This report replaces previous report.





- Ongoing through Friday 6/6 from 9 pm to 5 am each evening San Antonio/Ellison at/under I_25 will be CLOSED.
- Ongoing until Friday 6/6 at 5 pm I_25 northbound at San Mateo will have a single right lane closure.
- Ongoing until Saturday 6/7 at 5 am The I_25 northbound on ramp from Paseo Del Norte will be closed.
- Ongoing through Friday 6/6 from 9 am to 3 pm daytime and from 9 pm to 5 am overnight – Ellison eastbound at the southbound frontage road will have the right lane closed!! EXPECT DELAYS DURING THE DAYTIME!!
- Ongoing and until further notice The I_25 southbound Frontage Road from Paseo Del Norte to San Antonio will be one lane only.
- Ongoing and until further notice (Kiewit) The I_25 northbound frontage road from San Mateo/Osuna to just past Forest Hills will be reduced to one lane only. All lanes are restored just after Forest Hills.
- Ongoing and until further notice (Kiewit) The I_25 northbound frontage road before
 Paseo Del Norte will be reduced to one lane. Frontage road traffic must merge with I_25
 northbound off ramp traffic.
- Ongoing and until further notice (Kiewit) Paseo Del Norte eastbound from I_25 to the Lowe's/Target turn bay will have the right lane closed for triple right turn lane construction.
