



BF Goodrich North Island Four Wheel Drive Challenge

([PRWEB](#)) November 29, 1999 -- The BF Goodrich North Island Four Wheel Drive web site has been set up to publicise the biannual BF Goodrich North Island Four Wheel Drive Challenge - an off-road trip that takes place every two years in the North Island of New Zealand.

The inaugural trip took place during February and March 1999, and over the two-week period we (35 participants and 6 organisers) travelled the length of the North Island from Cape Reinga in the north to Wellington in the south. In between we visited the northern most point, the geographical centre and the southern most point of the island.

A similar trip - the Firestone South Island 4WD Experience - was held in February 1998 and everyone who participated had such a great time that we thought someone had to do a North Island one.

With access to the "back blocks" of New Zealand becoming more and more restricted, we are keen to take what opportunities currently exist to enjoy the uniqueness that makes New Zealand special. And, as the Tread Lightly programme promotes, we can demonstrate that our recreational trips are compatible with caring for the environment and preserving it for future generations.
