I-25/Missouri Bridge – Restrictions for Right Turns from Missouri Avenue to Triviz Drive

Las Cruces – The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) District One office along with FNF Construction continue with work along I-25 between Lohman Avenue (exit 3) and University Avenue (exit 1). The contractor has been working on the shoulder and within the median where northbound traffic has lane restrictions within this section of the roadway.

The I-25 Loop Ramp remains closed; however the alternate ramp for I-25 from on University remains open. Motorists traveling eastbound on University should remain on the passing (left) lane in order to access this ramp.

The contractor will have the right turning lane from Triviz Drive to Missouri Avenue closed starting at 6:00 a.m. Monday March 9th until 6:00 p.m. Friday March 13th. Motorists will have full access to left turns and to drive through the intersection where they will have the ability to make a right turn from this traffic lane. The contractor will have a large crane placed at this intersection in order to perform work that is necessary prior to the southbound bridge being demolished.

The bridge demolition for the southbound overpass is scheduled for March 27-30, which will require Missouri Avenue between Triviz Road and Don Roser to be closed as work is being performed.

The next Public Involvement Meeting is scheduled for Wednesday March 25, 2015 at the District One Complex located at 750 N. Solano in Las Cruces. The meeting will start promptly at 6:00 p.m. with members of the NMDOT, FNF and Molzen Corbin available to answer any questions the public may have regarding this project.
