## **Chip Seal Operations to Begin in Chaves County**

**Roswell** – The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) District Two will begin a project to chip seal pavement on various roadways in Chaves County.

The chip seal crew will begin work on Monday, March 30<sup>st</sup> along NM 254 (White Mill Road).

Drivers may encounter flaggers where work is being performed, as well as brief, intermittent lane closures. Additional routes scheduled for chip seal work include NM 254, NM 261, NM 255, NM 253, and NM 190.

Chip seal is a surface treatment on the pavement in an effort to preserve the life of the pavement surface by sealing out moisture, which can cause damage to pavement.

Remember to please drive safely through work zones.
