Bobcat Bridge Rehabilitation Work North of Santa Fe

Santa Fe—The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) will begin bridge rehabilitation work at Bobcat Road over I-25 Bridge at mile maker 288.300. The bridge rehabilitation will include a concrete deck overlay, repair of concrete structures, roadway rehabilitation and new guardrail installation.

Starting Monday, September 14, 2015 the Bobcat Road over I-25 Bridge will be reduced to one lane. Motorists can expect minor delays. Bobcat Road traffic will travel through one lane utilizing a temporary signal setup.

This bridge rehabilitation project is a scheduled to be completed in November of 2015; weather permitting. NMDOT thanks you for your patience during this bridge improvement project.

The Federal Highway Administration and the NMDOT have partnered to fund the improvements. The project amount is \$896,083.45. Kimo Constructors, Inc. of Bosque Farms, New Mexico is the contractor for this project.

Drivers are urged to proceed with caution through the work zone, observe traffic control signs and reduce speed to the posted limit. Updates on this project will be posted on the New Mexico Department of Transportation's road advisory website www.nmroads.com
