I-25 East Frontage Road Pavement Preservation Work Continues

Nambe—The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) will begin pavement preservation work on the I-25 East Frontage Road from NM 599 to the Waldo Canyon Interchange on June 9, 2015. NMDOT maintenance crews will be chip sealing the roadway. This work is anticipated to be completed by June 18. 2015.

Motorists can expect minor delays Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Starting Tuesday, June 9-10, the I-25 East Frontage road will be closed from La Cienega to Waldo Canyon. On June 11-18, there will be one lane closures with a flagger and pilot car operation escort.

The roadway will temporarily have loose gravel and no center stripe through the work zone. Drivers are advised to reduce speed and use caution. NMDOT thanks you for your patience during this pavement preservation improvement project.

Drivers are urged to proceed with caution through the work zone, observe traffic control signs and reduce speed to the posted limit. Updates on this project will be posted on the New Mexico Department of Transportation's road advisory website www.nmroads.com
