NM 68 Guardrail Replacement Work To Begin September 28

Taos—The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) will begin guardrail replacement work on NM 68 from mile post 29.7 (Jct. NM 570/NM 68) to mile post 33.5 (north side of Horseshoe) on Monday, September 28, 2015. The guardrail replacement work is scheduled for completion end of October 2015; weather permitting.

Motorists can expect traffic delays Monday through Friday from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. with some weekend work. There will be one lane closures with a pilot car escort and flagger operation through the work zone.

The guardrail replacement work is scheduled for completion end of October 2015; weather permitting. San Bar Construction Corp. of Albuquerque is the contractor for this project.

Drivers are urged to proceed with caution through the work zone, watch for construction personnel, observe traffic control signs and reduce speed to the posted limit. Updates on this project will be posted on the New Mexico Department of Transportation's road conditions website, www.nmroads.com
