In order to combat DUIs and alcohol-related accidents during prom season in Arizona, increased DUI patrols focus on specific locations, according to the East Valley DUI task force.

“Arizona has some of the strictest DUI laws in the country,” Corso said. “The consequences can be life altering.”

An underage DUI in Arizona can result in jail time, expensive fines and license suspension, affecting personal records, college and career applications.

If over the age of 21, increased penalties include the installment of an interlock ignition device after an extended period of license suspension.
