Based in Pittsburgh and founded in 1984, InventHelp is submitting the CAR TRACKER to companies for their review.

PITTSBURGH, PA ([PRWEB](#)) April 08, 2016 -- "I was following my brother from my aunt's house in DC, and I had to focus really hard to make sure it was his car," said one of two inventors from Dover, Del. "I said to myself that it would be great if there was a way I could know that I was following his car and not someone else's."

They developed the patent-pending CAR TRACKER to make it easier to follow a vehicle. The unit ensures that the vehicle stands out from other cars and trucks. This saves the driver following the vehicle from having to strain to see where the lead driver is going. Also, it keeps the following driver from missing turns or exits. The device features a highly visible design that can be seen both day and night. Furthermore, the invention is usable with any vehicle.

The original design was submitted to the Washington D.C. office of InventHelp. It is currently available for licensing or sale to manufacturers or marketers.
