The following meeting is a rolling Protest in support of the Auckland Co-Operative Taxi Society Shareholders against the current management control of the Society by elected Taxi Drivers to the management committee.

The protest is focusing on two key areas:

- 1) The continual refusal by the management committee to convene a special general meeting that has been requested by the members three (3) times in the past six weeks. Two of the motions for the Special General Meeting are for vote of no confidence in the Chairman and Vice Chairmen respectively. Note: The motions for a fourth request for a Special General Meeting are attached to this press release.
- 2) The management committee $\hat{A} \square s$ ongoing intimidation and interrogation of members who petitioned for signatures to the original request for a special general meeting. Two members, Kevin Kabir & Terry Carter are appearing before a second hearing committee for collecting signatures for this petition. The hearing committee, under the rules of the society, has complete management rights to expel these members without justification .
