The cost for a four-cylinder turbocharged model starts at the equivalent of \$43,000 in Germany, nearly double the starting price of under \$26,000 in the United States. For the more powerful V8 Ford GT, starting prices in Germany translate to \$50,000; in the United States that price is \$32,000.

Despite these higher rates, the V8 Ford GT is highly sought after, according to Ford manufacturers. Part of this popularity, some experts say, is due to it being well priced against local competitors. Few vehicles offer the same quality performance capabilities of the Mustang for the price.

It isn't just German and other European drivers excited about Ford Mustangs. In January this year, Edmunds.com announced Ford Mustang as the winner of their [Most Popular](#) award. This entry-level sports car simply can't be beat when it comes to a quality build paired with its appearance and desirable features. Drivers can choose from one of four engine models -- the 2.3L EcoBoost, 5.0L GT, 3.7L V6, and Shelby GT350 -- picking the right amount of power to meet your needs.
