



Is Waxing Lasting?

New discovery makes waxing your car obsolete.

So they wax again, Canady says, and each successive wax job dulls the original glow of the vehicle's paint.

Canady's firm, 5 Star Technologies, produces a product that protects the original paint by first removing environmental grime and then sealing the surface with a Teflon compound. It works so well that 5 Star Technologies guarantees a new car finish for 5 years.

In fact, 5 Star Shine was even chosen by the U.S. Navy to protect their Aegis radars on their ships. As these high-tech vessels travel the world's seas and suffer the effects of salt water and high winds, 5 Star Shine protects exposed radar equipment in the harshest marine environments.

So what is it that makes a 5 Star shine last and last? It's a patented two step chemical process, Canady says, a special wash that opens the pores in the paint and imparts a positive charge, which attracts an anionic Teflon solution that is magnetically pulled into the pores of paint.

The open pores of a painted surface are filled with the plasticizer, and it forms a barrier that will prevent the penetration of any other elements. Dirt, bugs, and road crud simply slide off the painted surface with a quick garden hose spray.

The formula plates, bonds and cross links the Teflon molecules and produces the depth of shine, the durability and corrosion protection. Unlike silicones treatments that attack the metal beneath the paint and create problems when the vehicle is stripped and repainted, the 5 Star Shine cross links in the paint alone and provides luminescent protection for years.
