

## **Automotive Lubricants Specifications Approved**

Standards for manufacturing motor oil are governed by organizations that control guidelines and specifications of the lubricant industry. Vehicles, for the next decade, will benefit of those stringent guidelines. GF-4 Specifications have been approved.

(PRWEB) September 11, 2003 -- ILSAC/Oil recently, as of Sept. 1, 2003, approved final draft limits of the GF-4 engine oil specifications, clearing the way for American Petroleum Institute (API) to publish it and begin licensing the new oils for 2005 model vehicles. According to ILSAC/Oil Chairman Bob Olree of General Motors, first licensing should begin no later than July 2004, and GF-3 licensing will cease after April 2005. Next on APIÂ $\Box$ s agenda will be developing GF-4Â $\Box$ s companion APIÂ $\Box$ s Â $\Box$ SÂ $\Box$  Service Category, most likely API SM.
