Currently, only gas-powered models are available, with the Highlander Hybrid slated to arrive in mid-February of 2014.

The base-level Highlander LE comes with an impressive array of standard features, including 18-inch alloy wheels, Entune Audio with a 6.1-inch touchscreen, an integrated backup camera, heated side mirrors with turn signal indicators, an in-dash shelf with easy access to power and USB ports, a windshield wiper de-icer, and much more. Available upgrades include a pre-collision system with Dynamic Radar Cruise Control, Lane Departure Alert with automatic high beam headlights, a panoramic moonroof, a heated steering wheel, and heated second-row captain's chairs.

"The Highlander has been a favorite among our customers for a number of years because it's a roomy and versatile family SUV," said Steve Reedy, the general sales manager at Prestige Toyota. "For 2014, Toyota has given customers even more of a good thing by adding room for an eighth passenger. The bold, updated styling on this vehicle is sure to make it a popular choice for years to come. We can't wait for our customers to come in and see it in person."

The Highlander is the fourth redesigned vehicle to be added to Toyota's 2014 lineup, joining the Corolla, Tundra, and 4Runner.
