Her career has been devoted to representing the freight transportation community from both a policy and business operating perspective.

Active in numerous professional organizations, Ms. Casey has served on various industry committees and boards including the Executive Committee of the Transportation Research Board; the University of Denver's Transportation Institute; the Global Maritime and Transportation School of the U.S. Merchant Marine Academy; the Board of Advisors of the Smith School of Business at the University of Maryland; and the Business Advisory Committee of Northwestern University.

"Joni Casey's dedication has created a long-lasting, positive impact on the intermodal industry and ultimately benefits American commerce. We are grateful for her continued service," said CII President Michael DiVirgilio. "CII is proud to present this year's Lifetime Achievement Award to Ms. Casey, who has devoted so much of her career to improving our industry."
