According to The California Office of Traffic Safety, the number of distracted drivers viewed during a one-month period for April 2016 was at about thirteen percent. This is much greater than what was observed in the year prior, with distracted drivers being calculated at about nine percent. However, tickets are being issued at a lower rate than in the past. This is due in part to new hands-free devices available. It can be hard to an officer to prove electronic usage while driving in this manner.

It is important to note that an officer can issue a ticket for distracted driving if the driver was witnessed using a cell phone while driving. If driving behavior was also affected, additional charges may be issued, such a reckless driving citation. Because traffic violations can lead to a <u>suspended driver's license</u> and more, drivers are encouraged to seek legal counsel to minimize the impact of the consequences of these offenses.
