

Vehicle Safety Accessory Invented by InventHelp Client (LGI-2195)

A Pittsburgh-based invention company, InventHelp is submitting the BB SAFETY LIGHTS to companies for their consideration.

Pittsburgh, PA (<u>PRWEB</u>) October 11, 2016 -- An inventor from Port Washington, N.Y. wanted a way to more easily alert oncoming traffic when a car door is opening. To that end, she invented the patent-pending BB SAFETY LIGHTS, a device that would enable the user to open a car door safely, especially at night.

The BB SAFETY LIGHTS is a device that would be easy to use by any motorist. It would utilize a unique design that would be inexpensive to install. It could also operate in conjunction with any vehicle's electrical system.
