The invention eliminates the need to change a flat tire on the side of a dangerous roadway. The unit reduces the risk of being struck by a vehicle while changing a tire. It is designed to enhance personal safety by minimizing the risk of injury. The accessory offers added peace of mind. Additionally, it is adaptable for use with virtually any motor vehicle.
