

Motor Vehicle Child Detection System Invented by InventHelp Client (FLA-2783)

PITTSBURGH, PA (<u>PRWEB</u>) November 26, 2016 -- The frequency of new stories regarding serious injury or death to children resulting from being left behind in a hazardously hot or cold vehicle is unnerving. These stories often result from extremely busy parents forgetting to bring their child inside, a mistake that may result in tragedy.

An inventor from Delray Beach, Fla., has invented the patent-pending CHILD SAVER, a device that detects if a child is left unattended and alerts the parents if they move a certain distance away from the vehicle. "I often hear stories about children getting seriously injured and even dying after being left in a vehicle unattended," said the inventor. "I felt compelled to invent a device that prevents parents from leaving their child in their car, potentially saving lives." CHILD SAVER gives busy parents peace of mind that they will never mistakenly leave their child in the car.

This invention also works for animals and would appeal to owners of cats and dog.
