Traffic Report for week of January 29, 2017

White Sands Missile Range Notification

White Sands Missile Range (WSMR) has posted an alert for Tuesday January 31, 2017 for US 70 at 6:55 am and will last approximately one hour. The roadblocks will be located on HWY 70 at This block will be located at Blue Block (2 miles East of the access road - Mile Marker 172) and Brown Block (Mile Marker-192). St. Augustin Pass, LC Gate, will not be affected. Nike Ave will be affected by this block.

I-10 Mile Marker 85 for Bridge Repairs, Deming CN 1101320

The New Mexico Department of Transportation and Hasse Contractors (Contractor) will be performing joint repair work. I-10 at MP 85 Bridge will have various lane closures for bridge deck and joint repairs. Construction operation hours will be from 7:00 am to 6:00 pm, Monday through Friday. Please use caution in this area when workers are present.

I-10 Deming – Mile Marker 91.7 to 94.5 CN 1101250

The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) along with La Calerita Construction (Contractor) will be performing bridge rehabilitation and roadway reconstruction operations to Interstate 10 (I-10) in Luna County; Construction is expected to be completed by summer 2017. Interstate traffic will encounter a detour while work is being performed and all interstate traffic is detoured off the westbound lane and will be sharing the eastbound lane, barrier wall is in use. An 11' width lane restriction is in effect. Motorists are asked to reduce speed, obey posted signs, and use extreme caution, and be cautious of personnel in the area.

I-25 Mile Markers 51 to 75, Hatch

The New Mexico Department of Transportation and J-H Supply (Contractor) will be completing final cable barrier installation in the median. There will be moving lane closures on this project. Work is expected to last until end of February 2017. Motorists are asked to reduce speed, obey posted signs, and use extreme caution, and be cautious of personnel in the area.

<u>I-25 T or C Fog Seal – MP 85.6 to 89</u>

The NMDOT announces the following traffic alert information for Interstate 25, mile post 85.6 to mile post 89, performing fog sealing of roadway in Sierra County. The Speed limit will be reduced to 55 mph starting at 7:00 a.m. and will be lifted at 3:30p.m. daily, Monday through Friday. Traffic will encounter closures of the off and on ramps temporarily. Striping to be complete in February, motorists

are advised use caution and reduce speed while nearing and passing through the work zone being cautious of trucks turning and workers in the area.

US 70 Mile Markers 166.25 to 177.740, Las Cruces CN 1100570

The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) along with Mountain States Contractors, Inc. (Contractor) will be performing roadway rehabilitation operations on US 70 in Dona Ana Co. Construction will begin Monday, January 30, 2017 and is expected to be completed by summer 2017. An 12' width lane restriction is in effect. Traffic will encounter lane drops at times with eastbound and westbound exits closed off to all traffic as needed. Motorists are asked to reduce speed, obey posted signs, and use extreme caution, and be cautious of personnel in the area. The closure will be in affect from 7:00 am to 5:00 pm.

NM 26 MP 0.0 to 25.0, Deming 1101330/1101331

The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) along with Mountain States Constructors (Contractor) will be performing roadway reconstruction operations to NM 26 in Luna County, Construction is expected to be completed by Spring 2017. A 12' width lane restriction is in effect. Traffic will encounter a pilot car operation while work is being performed. Motorists are asked to reduce speed, obey posted signs, and use extreme caution, and be cautious of personnel in the area.

NM 26 MP 21.9, Deming CN 1101280

The New Mexico Department of Transportation and Hasse Contractors (Contractor) will be performing joint repair work. NM 26 at MP 21.9 Bridge will have various shoulder closures for rip rap installation under the bridge. Construction operation hours will be from 7:00 am to 6:00 pm, Monday through Friday. Please use caution in this area when workers are present.

NM 28, Mile Marker 19.5 - Bridge Reconstruction, San Miguel

The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) along with AUI Inc. (Contractor) will begin work on a bridge replacement on NM 28 at milepost 19.5 (at Avenida Del Panteon). Construction is expected to last through February 2017. Traffic will encounter a pilot car operation while work is being performed. Motorists are asked to reduce speed, obey posted signs, and use extreme caution, and be cautious of personnel in the area.

NM 186, Mile Marker 0.7 –Bridge Reconstruction, Anthony The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) along with AUI Inc. (Contractor) will begin work on a bridge replacement on NM 186 at milepost 0.7 (W Ohara Rd). Construction at this location is expected to last through spring 2017. During this time period, NM 186 at this location will be completely CLOSED to traffic at all times. Through traffic along NM 186 is advised to be on alert and look for detour signs which will be posted throughout the area to guide traffic around the road closure.

NM 159 Mogollon – Mile Marker 8 to 10 CN ER14103

The NMDOT along with La Calerita Construction, LLC, (Contractor) will perform Roadway & Drainage Improvements on NM 159 with expected completion fall of 2017. The only traffic that will be able to go through NM 159 will be the Mogollon residence and supplies for the Mogollon residence during the week. La Calerita will be working Monday through Saturday until winter weather conditions exist. **NM 159 will be open for the weekend.**

US 60 Mile Marker 136, Socorro CN 1100840

The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) along with FNF Construction (Contractor) will be reconstructing the bridge US 60, mile marker 136. FNF will be back in the area but should not affect travel on US 60.

Las Cruces Projects – City of Las Cruces

Bex Court

From Bex Street to cul-de-sac will be closed to through traffic. Access to residents will be maintained at all times. Motorists will be asked to decrease speed through the construction zone and should proceed with caution.

Bex Street

From Farney Lane to Desert Rose Court will be closed to through traffic. Access to residents will be maintained at all times. Motorists will be asked to decrease speed through the construction zone and should proceed with caution.

Desert Rose Court

From Bex Street to cul-de-sac will be closed to through traffic. Access to residents will be maintained at all times. Motorists will be asked to decrease speed through the construction zone and should proceed with caution.

Farney Lane

From Main Street to Hixon Drive will be closed to through traffic. Access to residents will be maintained at all times. Motorists will be asked to decrease speed through the construction zone and should proceed with caution.

Farney Lane

From El Paseo Road to Espina Drive will be closed to through traffic. Access to residents will be maintained at all times. Motorists will be asked to decrease speed through the construction zone and should proceed with caution.

McGuffey Street

From Windridge Circle to Sirena Lane will be closed to through traffic. Detours are in place. Access to residents will be maintained at all times. Motorists will be asked to decrease speed through the construction zone and should proceed with caution.

Nemesh Drive

From Mohegan Trail to Mages Street will be closed to through traffic. Access to residents will be maintained at all times. Motorists will be asked to decrease speed through the construction zone and should proceed with caution.

Roadrunner Parkway

From Golf Club Road to Santo Domingo Avenue will have the inside north and south bound lanes closed to through traffic. Access to residents will be maintained at all times. Motorists will be asked to decrease speed through the construction zone and should proceed with caution.

Utah Avenue

From El Paseo Road to Mesquite Street will be closed to through traffic. Access to businesses will be detoured for full access. Motorists will be asked to decrease speed through the construction zone and should proceed with caution.

El Paso Projects – Go 10/Border West Expressway

Mesa @ I-10

Continuous for about 4 more weeks

The following closures started on Jan.18 and will continue until 4 p.m. on Friday, Feb. 24

- The right turn-only lane on North Mesa Street (SH 20) will close between Osborne Drive and South Desert Boulevard (traveling in the direction toward I-10).
- The right through lane on North Mesa Street (SH 20) will also close between Osborne Drive and South Desert Boulevard (traveling in the direction toward I-10); however, when possible, crews will open the through lane during rush hours and at night.

Note: Two lanes will remain open on N. Mesa St. (SH 20) and business access will be open at all times. Crews will be installing underground utilities.

Resler @ I-10

9 p.m. each night to 6 a.m. each morning

• The Resler Flyover Ramp to I-10 Eastbound will close.

Crews will be working on the existing ramp structure.

I-10 @ Resler

9 p.m. each night to 6 a.m. each morning

- I-10 Westbound will completely close at the Resler Exit Ramp (Exit 12).
- The left lane on I-10 Eastbound will close between the North Mesa Entrance Ramp and just past the Resler Flyover Ramp.

Detour: Motorists on I-10 West will exit at Resler Drive (Exit 12) and take North Mesa Street (SH 20) westward to I-10 where they can re-enter I-10 West.

Crews will be setting steel beams at the Resler Flyover Ramp.

I-10 @ Mesa

Overnight

Sunday, Jan. 29 and Monday, Jan. 30

9 p.m. each night to 6 a.m. each morning

- I-10 Eastbound will completely close at the North Mesa Exit Ramp (Exit 11).
- The left lane on I-10 Westbound will close between the Sunland Park Overpass and the North Mesa Underpass.

Detour: Motorists on I-10 East will exit at North Mesa Street (Exit 11), take Doniphan Drive to Sunland Park Drive, and will be able to re-enter I-10 from Sunland Park Drive. NOTE: Doniphan Drive does not provide access to I-10 nor to US 85 after Sunland Park Drive. Keep to the detour route.

Crews will be setting steel beams at the Resler Flyover Ramp.

Overnight

Sunday, Jan. 29 through Sunday, Feb. 5

9 p.m. each night to 6 a.m. each morning

• I-10 in both directions will reduce to one lane at the North Mesa intersection overpass between Thorn Avenue and approximately 100 feet east of North Mesa Street (SH 20).

Crews will be installing temporary wire retaining walls.

I-10 @ Executive

NEW – Overnight

Tuesday, Jan. 31 through Thursday, Feb. 2

9 p.m. each night to 6 a.m. each morning

- I-10 Eastbound will reduce to one lane from the Sunland Park Overpass to the Asarco Bridge
- The Executive Center Boulevard Exit Ramp (eastbound) will close.
- The Executive Center Boulevard Entrance Ramp (eastbound) will close.
- I-10 Westbound will reduce to two lanes between the Asarco Bridge and the Executive Center Overpass.
- The Executive Center Boulevard Exit Ramp (westbound) will close.

Crews will be paving, patching potholes, and removing high mast lighting poles.
