**NMDOT District 3
Roadwork Advisory Report**

Interstate

I-25 Northbound off-ramp to I-40 Eastbound closed and I-40 Eastbound two right lanes over University Boulevard closed. Project A300697

Oct. 21 at 9 p.m. to Oct. 24 at 5 a.m. NMDOT and Contractor: Truesdell Corp. will be performing bridgework resulting in a full closure of the I-25 Northbound to I-40 eastbound transition ramp. On I-40 eastbound over University Boulevard motorists can expect a two lane closure. Motorists follow detour signage in place. All lanes will be reopened by 5 a.m. on Monday Oct. 24, unless crews complete work early. Project Manager: Jeremy Maestas

I-25 northbound at milepost 252 (San Felipe) single lane closure

Crews will be performing bridge preservation work on northbound I-25 at San Felipe beginning Fri. Oct. 22 at 9 p.m. through Monday Oct. 24, at 5 a.m. This will be a single lane closure for bridge work. (On and Off ramps at San Felipe will be open.)

U.S. Highways

US 550 southbound east of NM 313-Camino Del Pueblo (Bernalillo) intermittent lane closures at intersection

Through Oct. 31, 2016, from 6 a.m. - 4 p.m. TLC Plumbing and Utility will be doing utility work and installing a deceleration lane on Southbound US 550.

State Roadways:

NM 6 east and westbound from mile marker 18 to 23 Project: A300420

NMDOT and Mountain States Constructors, Inc. are performing roadway reconstruction on NM 6 east and westbound through November 22, 2016. The project zone is reduced to one lane with a flagging and pilot car operation 24 hours daily. Motorists can expect reduced speeds and delays. Project Manager: Patsy Najar.

NM 45 at Central Ave. NW

October 10-Dec. 20, 2016 7 a.m. - 7 p.m. Bradbury Stamm Construction, Inc. Contractor. Roadway construction, signal, lighting work for intersection improvements for the Albuquerque Rapid Transit system. Various lane closures in eastbound direction on Coors Boulevard.



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NM 45 Coors Boulevard between Montano Boulevard and Irving Boulevard Milepost 18.07 to 20.9

Project: A300016/A300018 NMDOT with Contractor: Mountain States Constructors, Inc. will be doing pavement preservation (mill and inlay) work as well as ADA ramp and sidewalk reconstruction through November 20, normal crew hours: 7 p.m. – 5 a.m. nightly. Motorists can expect double lane closures on northbound and southbound Coors from Montano to Irving. Beginning Oct. 31, day work will begin. Sidewalks closed during construction. Flaggers will be on site assisting motorists. NMDOT Project Manager: Emiliano Martinez.

NM 45 Coors Boulevard southbound right lane closure at La Orilla

Oct. 19 through Nov. 17, 2016; 9 a.m. – 4 p.m. right lane closed for roadwork. Contractor: Franklin's Earthmoving.

NM 45 Coors Boulevard at Arenal Rd SW northbound

Oct. 25-November 11, 2016 from 9 a.m. – 3 p.m. or 9 p.m. – 5 a.m. Crews will be using a mobile operation for utility work. Contractor: Pro Pipe

NM 47 in Peralta, NM between Milepost 31 to 32.8 (Peralta) north and southbound lanes (Project 3100300) Project Manager, Chris Sinclair/AUI, Inc. Project Contractor NMDOT and Contractor AUI, are reconstructing a portion of NM 47 through the town of Peralta. Expected Project Completion: Late October 2016

Crew hours: 6 a.m. - 6 p.m. Monday - Saturday; traffic will be reduced to one north and southbound lane with a center left turn lane on NM 47 at milepost 31-32.8. Motorists reduce speed to 35 m.p.h. in work zone. Work zone speed strictly enforced.

NM 500 between University and Broadway (NM 47) various lane closures for utility work.

Through Oct. 22, 2016 from 9 a.m. - 3 p.m. Contractor: Cobb Fendley

NM 528 eastbound and westbound from 2nd street NW to Corrales Road (Milemarker 1-4)

Hours: 9 p.m. – 5 a.m. through Oct. 30, 2016; NMDOT and contractor: Albuquerque Asphalt, are doing pavement preservation work on East and Westbound Alameda Boulevard from 2nd street NW to Corrales Road. Motorists expect various lane closures throughout project.
