*Traffic Report for week of **December 4, 2016***

White Sands Missile Range Notification

I-25 Mile Marker 100 for Bridge Repairs, T or C

The New Mexico Department of Transportation and Hasse Contractors (Contractor) will be performing joint repair work. A signaled stop light will be in place on the MP 100 Bridge (Red Rock) affecting travel over bridge way both east and west bound lanes. I-25 at mile post 100 will have various lane closures for bridge deck and joint repairs above. Please use caution in this area when workers are present. Construction operation hours will be from 7:00 am to 6:00 pm, Monday through Friday. Please use caution in this area when workers are present.

I-25 Mile Marker 79 for Lighting Replacement, T or C [CN9900705](#)

The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) along with RT Electric (Contractor) will begin lighting replacement on I-25 at mile post 79, T or C exit, both northbound and southbound lanes may be affected. Highway traffic will encounter intermittent shoulder closures and possible lane closures as needed. Motorists are asked to reduce speed, obey posted signs, and use extreme caution, and be cautious of personnel in the area.

I-10 Deming – Mile Marker 91.7 to 94.5 [CN 1101250](#)

The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) along with La Calerita Construction (Contractor) will be performing bridge rehabilitation and roadway reconstruction operations to Interstate 10 (I-10) in Luna County; Construction is expected to be completed by summer 2017. Interstate traffic will encounter a detour while work is being performed with the initial detour in the eastbound lanes. Detour will be utilized starting in December. An 11' width lane restriction is in effect. Motorists are asked to reduce speed, obey posted signs, and use extreme caution, and be cautious of personnel in the area.

I-10 Lordsburg – Mile Marker 29 [CN 1100611](#)

The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) along with James Hamilton Construction (Contractor) will be performing bridge repair work and partial reconstruction of the roadway. Traffic has been moved back with no detour in place. Motorists are asked to reduce speed, obey posted signs, and use extreme caution, and be cautious of personnel in the area.

NM 26 MP 45.5, Hatch [CN1101270](#)

The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) along with Villalobos Construction (Contractor) will begin Bridge Preservation Repair maintenance work on NM 26 at mile post 45.

Construction is expected to be completed by winter 2016. Highway traffic will encounter a single lane drop at times. Motorists are asked to reduce speed, obey posted signs, and use extreme caution, and be cautious of personnel in the area. The closure will be in affect from 6:30 am to 5:00 pm, Monday through Friday as needed.

NM 26 MP 0.0 to 25.0, Deming [1101330/1101331](#)

The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) along with Mountain States Constructors (Contractor) will be performing roadway reconstruction operations to NM 26 in Luna County, Construction is expected to be completed by Spring 2017. A 12' width lane restriction is in effect. Traffic will encounter a pilot car operation while work is being performed. Motorists are asked to reduce speed, obey posted signs, and use extreme caution, and be cautious of personnel in the area.

NM 28, Mile Marker 19.5 –Bridge Reconstruction, San Miguel

The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) along with AUI Inc. (Contractor) will begin work on a bridge replacement on NM 28 at milepost 19.5 (at Avenida Del Panteon). Construction is expected to last through February 2017. During this time period, NM 28 at this location will be completely CLOSED to traffic until the middle of December. Through traffic along NM 28 is advised to be on alert and look for detour signs which will be posted throughout the area to guide traffic around the road closure.

NM 159 Mogollon – Mile Marker 8 to 10 [CN ER14103](#)

The NMDOT along with La Calerita Construction, LLC, (Contractor) will perform Roadway & Drainage Improvements on NM 159 with expected completion fall of 2017. The only traffic that will be able to go through NM 159 will be the Mogollon residence and supplies for the Mogollon residence during the week. La Calerita will be working Monday through Saturday until winter weather conditions exist. **NM 159 will be open for the weekend.**

I-25 T or C Fog Seal – MP 58 to 64

The NMDOT announces the following traffic alert information for Interstate 25, mile post 58 to mile post 64, performing fog sealing of roadway in Sierra County. The Speed limit will be reduced to 55 mph starting at 7:00 a.m. and will be lifted at 3:30p.m. daily, Monday through Friday. Traffic will encounter closures of the off and on ramps temporarily. Striping to be complete in November, motorists are advised use caution and reduce speed while nearing and passing through the work zone being cautious of trucks turning and workers in the area.

Las Cruces Projects – City of Las Cruces

Bex Court

From Bex Street to cul-de-sac will be closed to through traffic. Access to residents will be maintained at all times. Motorists will be asked to decrease speed through the construction zone and should proceed with caution.

Bex Street

From Farney Lane to Desert Rose Court will be closed to through traffic. Access to residents will be maintained at all times. Motorists will be asked to decrease speed through the construction zone and should proceed with caution.

Clifford Avenue

From Mesa Grande Drive to Stewards Drive will be closed to through traffic. Access to residents will be maintained at all times. Motorists will be asked to decrease speed through the construction zone and should proceed with caution.

Desert Rose Court

From Bex Street to cul-de-sac will be closed to through traffic. Access to residents will be maintained at all times. Motorists will be asked to decrease speed through the construction zone and should proceed with caution.

El Prado

From Melendres Street to Brown Road will be closed to through traffic. Access to residents will be maintained at all times. Motorists will be asked to decrease speed through the construction zone and should proceed with caution.

Farney Lane

From Main Street to Hixon Drive will be closed to through traffic. Access to residents will be maintained at all times. Motorists will be asked to decrease speed through the construction zone and should proceed with caution.

Lee's Drive

Open to through traffic.

Nemesh Drive

From Mohegan Trail to Mages Street will be closed to through traffic. Access to residents will be maintained at all times. Motorists will be asked to decrease speed through the construction zone and should proceed with caution.

Pinon Street

From Mesquite Street to N. Virginia Street will be closed to through traffic. Access to residents will be maintained at all times. Motorists will be asked to decrease speed near the construction zone and should proceed with caution.

El Paso Projects – Go 10/Border West Expressway

I-10 and Mesa

Overnight

Sunday, Dec. 4-Thursday, Dec. 8

9 p.m. each night to 6 a.m. each morning

- I-10 Westbound will be completely closed between the North Mesa Exit Ramp (Exit 11) and the North Mesa Entrance Ramp.
- I-10 Eastbound will be reduced to one lane between the North Mesa Exit Ramp (Exit 11) and North Mesa Entrance Ramp.
- North Mesa Street (SH 20) will be completely closed in both directions between North and South Desert Boulevard frontage roads.

GO 10 recommends people avoid the intersection during the operation or follow the detour signs in place.

Crews will be moving 30 bridge beams into the area and using two cranes to set those beams into place. The longest beam is 164-feet long, more than six-feet tall, weighs 57 tons, and will completely span North Mesa Street (SH 20) once in place. This marks the first of three phases that will transform the I-10 Overpass at North Mesa Street (SH 20). **DETOUR:** The detour will be substantial for drivers who wish to travel along North Mesa Street (SH 20).

9 p.m. to 5 a.m.

- The I-10 Westbound Executive Exit Ramp (Exit 16) will be closed.

Crews will be removing barrier walls.

I-10 East

Daytime

Monday, Dec. 5-Friday, Dec. 9

9 a.m. to 4 p.m. each day

- A left lane on I-10 Eastbound will be closed for about a half mile between North Mesa Street (SH 20) and the Resler Flyover Ramp.

Crews will be working on bridge columns. Fact: There are 29 bridges in the **GO 10** work zone and all of them will be expanded.

PLEASE NOTE: Conditions are subject to change without notice. Double fines for speeding in work zones are in effect.
