

Inventor Develops Seat-Belt Accessory for Children (CCP-1236)

InventHelp, founded in 1984 in Pittsburgh, is attempting to submit this idea, the Seatbelt Latch Cover, to applicable companies for their consideration.

"I came up with this idea so that children could not undo their buckles without assistance."

She created a prototype for the SEATBELT LATCH COVER to prevent a child from unbuckling his or her seat belt while the vehicle is in motion. The device eliminates the need for the driver to pull over in order to buckle children back up. This enables the driver to concentrate fully on the road ahead. It is designed to keep children buckled up so that they remain safe during travel, which offers added peace of mind to parents and caregivers. Furthermore, the accessory is adaptable for use in any new or existing vehicle.

The original design was submitted to the Chicago office of InventHelp. It is currently available for licensing or sale to manufacturers or marketers.
